Applications are invited for the post of a Field Attendant (01) in a Ministry of Environment and Forests sponsored project "Utilization of ants as bioindicators to monitor environmental pollution in coal mine spoils" as per qualifications given below:

Intermediate (Science) with 2-3 years experience. Maximum age (yrs): 30 yrs (5 years relaxation for female/SC/ST/OBC/PH candidates). Salary: Rs. 5000/- per month, fixed.

The selected candidate must be prepared to spend about 10-12 days per month for doing field work (mainly digging coal mine dump soil for putting pitfall traps) at Singrauli, M.P.
