



Foundation Stone for construction of new 132/33 KV Sub Substation Laid

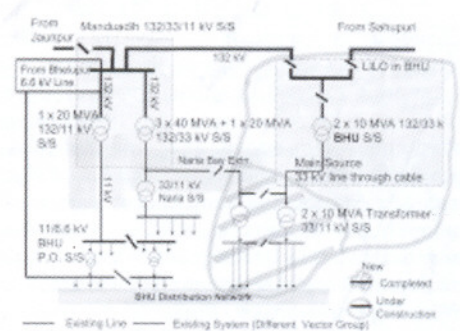

After commissioning and interconnection of the sub station with UPPCL grid through two 33 KV underground cable, BHU will get the reliable and improved power supply. Commissioning of this 10 Crore project will not only help in getting rid of rostering, reduction in expenditure on D G sets and power-loss in old system but would improve the availability of power supply to BHU. Maintenance cost will also decrease helping total cost recovery within 6 to 8 years. The Power Grid Corporation of India is executing the Project.

Interest in deepseabed mining has revived: Expert

“Interest in the mineral resources of the deep seabed has experienced a revival in recent years. Unlike that of the late 1960s and 1970s, current interest is based on scientific research and economic understanding, rather than unbridled speculation based on a limited data and underdeveloped technological capability of past,” said eminent geologist Prof G S Roonwal.

Prof Roonwal, the former Head of Geology Department at Delhi University was delivering Prof K K Mathur Memorial Lecture on ‘Deep Seabed Mining, the second Time Around’ during Geology Day Celebrations on 6 October. Geology Department had organised this function to mark its 87th foundation day.

“This outlook for development of deep seabed mineral must give consideration to competing land-based resources, as well future markets for hard minerals,” he said. “Also of interest is the location of resource deposit and the national and international legal and regulatory regime for their development.

These factors will affect the outlook for development of seabed mineral resources in terms of their potential, prospect and limitations.”

Prof Roonwal, also chairman of Federation of Indian Mineral Industries, added, “greater demands for mineral depends upon economic growth and increase industrial development around the world. The initial period of commercial interest in seabed minerals was cut short as the growth rate of metal demand declined when developed countries increasingly shifted to post-industrial economics.”

“New sources of minerals and increased efficiency have kept to growth of mineral demand flow for many years, but this pattern is beginning to change,” he said.

“Economic growth in developing countries specially China, India and Brazil and the former Soviet block will tighten the market and push prices for industrial and precious metals to higher levels, as we are witnessing today. Changing patterns of economic growth, new demands in response to the growth of electronic sector, developments in automotive technology and long lead times for development of new mines and processing facilities, all contribute to a long term outlook for tighter supplies and rising prices,” he said.

“Large land-based mineral resources assure that existing mineral will be continue to be a source of metals, but eventually it will be necessary to develop new greenfield deposits,” he said. “Trends in metal use and mineral production will support serious consideration of the commercial development of deep seabed mineral deposits,” he added.

Earlier, Head of Geology Department, Prof R N Tiwari welcomed the guests whereas Prof Rajesh Srivastava remarked about Geology Day celebrations.

हिन्दी दिवस (14 सितम्बर, 2006) पर आयोजित कार्यशाला

हिन्दी दिवस (14 सितम्बर, 2006) के पावन अवसर पर जनपद अभियांत्रिकी विभाग, के संगोष्ठी कक्ष में प्रौद्योगिकी संस्थान की ओर से तकनीकी शिक्षा में हिन्दी माध्यम के प्रयोग को प्रोत्साहित करने हेतु ‘तकनीकी शिक्षा में हिन्दी माध्यम का प्रयोग’ विषय पर एक कार्यशाला का आयोजन किया गया। मुख्य अतिथि का संभाषण प्रौद्योगिकी संस्थान के निदेशक प्रो. सिद्धनाथ उपाध्याय ने किया। उन्होंने हिन्दी शब्दकोशों में प्रयुक्त कुछ तकनीकी शब्दों का उदाहरण देते हुए बताया कि किस प्रकार तकनीकी शिक्षा में हिन्दी का प्रयोग काफी कठिन कार्य है। अध्यक्षीय भाषण देते हुए संकाय प्रमुख प्रो. वीरेन्द्र सिंह ने हिन्दी माध्यम को प्रोत्साहित करने की आवश्यकता पर बल दिया अभियांत्रिकी विभाग के अध्यक्ष प्रो. राज किशोर अग्रवाल ने बताया कि मनोभावों को व्यक्त करने का सर्वोत्कृष्ट माध्यम मातृभाषा है तथा इसके प्रयोग से तकनीकी शिक्षा को अधिक प्रभावशाली बनाने में सहायता मिलेगी। उन्होंने कहा कि अब शीघ्रताशीघ्र हिन्दी भाषा को तकनीकी शिक्षा में माध्यम के रूप में अपनाने की महती आवश्यकता है। उन्होंने यह भी बताया कि अभी तकनीकी शिक्षा में स्नातक, परास्नातक या शोध के स्तर पर हिन्दी माध्यम में उपयुक्त पुस्तकें ही उपलब्ध नहीं हैं तथा इस कमी को शीघ्रतापूर्वक पूरा करने की आवश्यकता है।



कार्यशाला के संयोजक डा. देवेन्द्र मोहन ने बताया कि किस प्रकार विविध राष्ट्रों ने अपनी मातृभाषा का तकनीकी शिक्षा में प्रयोग करके शीघ्र उन्नति प्राप्त की है। हिन्दी माध्यम के तकनीकी शिक्षा में प्रयोग के समय आने वाली कुछ महत्वपूर्ण समस्याओं तथा इनसे संबंधित संभावित समाधानों का भी उल्लेख किया। जर्मनी, जापान, चीन, फ्रांस आदि देशों ने अपनी राष्ट्रभाषा को तकनीकी शिक्षा में प्रोत्साहन दिया तथा विकास के पथ पर शीघ्रतापूर्वक अग्रसर हुए। यह एक भ्रांति है कि अंग्रेजी के बिना देश विकास नहीं कर सकता। उन्होंने यह भी बताया कि भारत की भाषायी विविधता हिन्दी को अपनाने में बाधक नहीं है, बशर्ते कि मजबूत राजनैतिक व इच्छा शक्ति का प्रयोग किया जाय।

India will be key player

With its talent and resource in high technology, India will be key player in shaping the global knowledge economy. Panelists at the seminar on "The New India: Opportunities and Challenge in the Knowledge economy" said at K N Udapa auditorium in Banaras Hindu University here on 7 October. The seminar was organised by the American Embassy's SPAN magazine, in cooperation with Banaras Hindu University, US Educational Foundation in India and Indo-American Chambers of Commerce.

During the panel discussion, Ms Corina R Sanders, editor-in-Chief of SPAN said that the SPAN programme at Varanasi and Allahabad is part of an initiative to reach out to more readers, emphasising key themes in transforming US-India relationship. She expressed hope that today's event will strengthen the cultural bridge between the United States and India by expanding SPAN's current readership.

Speaking on the global knowledge economy, US scholar Dr. Rafiq Dossani said that the education and high skill bring differences between rich and poor nation and with changing world's economic system, everyone has to change their attitude towards job.

He said that with development many thing left back and many thing take place instead of them and said that losing job by Americans due to outsourcing should be seen in this context.

Dr Dossani said that nearly 80 lakh Americans change their jobs every year which indicating flexible attitude of the Americans.

Praising young India talents, he said that there is need of more supportive educational system and high skill for Indian students to meet the US talent so that they are merely proved complementary to US students.

Dr. Vijaya Khandavilli of the US Educational Foundation in India said that Indian students are more subjects focused, while they should keep broad knowledge so that they could open their option in other sector also. Praising US education system she said that US educational institute provide opportunity to students to get more practical knowledge and Indian institute should also provide such opportunities so that student could get more expertise.

Dr. Khandavilli said that except other thing education should be student centric and interactive rather than present education pattern and added that motive of education should be developing independent thinking and problem solution abilities in students.

Prof S Lele, BHU Rector, speaking as a chief guest, said that in new millennium India is emerging as economic power in the world but without imparting the benefit to poor, development would be meaningless.

He said that on one hand opportunity is knocking

the door, while on the other hand widening gap between poor and rich is emerging as threat to the nation.

The programme started with garlanding of Pt Madan Mohan Malaviya's portrait by Prof S Lele and Dr. Rafiq Dossani. Vote of thank was expressed by Puneet Raman.

Other prominent speakers were Prof Sushila Singh, Principal, Women's College, BHU Prof Ashok Kaul, Department of Sociology, BHU Dr. Vishwanath Pandey, Public Relations Officer, BHU and Giriraj Agarwal. Earlier Member of national executive of Indo-American Chambers of Commerce Sri Ashok Kapoor welcomed the guests.

The students of W.H. Smith Memorial School, Sunbeam School, Bhagwanpur and Lahartara took part in interactive session discussions.

Issues with Nepal should be taken up

Nepal is at the crossroads of peace and the political economy of the country is determined by internal as well as external dynamics. This was stated by MP Lama, Professor of South Asian studies at the Jawaharlal Nehru University (New Delhi)

He was delivering the keynote address during the inaugural function of two-day international seminar on 'Challenges of Democracy and Development in Nepal' at Arts Faculty auditorium on 18 December. Centre for the Study of Nepal organized the seminar.

Prof Lama said the socio-economic development of Nepal had been abysmal low, ridden by caste conflicts language and citizenship identities, internal discontentment and communal disturbances. "Seven years of Maoist insurgency has completely devastated the Himalayan Kingdom," he said.

He added that there were some crucial questions before Nepal such as who will manage the 'New Nepal' when the age-old institution of monarchy is uprooted, who will manage the Maoist cadre and what would be their approach towards development?

He said in the context of Indo-Nepal relations there were possibilities of rethinking and restructuring of relations from both sides.

Prof Pushpesh Pant of JNU pointed out immense diversities of Nepal and stressed upon age-old relationship with Nepal. He underlined the need for addressing issues related to cross-border smuggling, narcotics trade and trafficking of women etc.

He said there was a fear in Indian minds that rise of Maoist rule in Nepal may lead to demands for separation by Sikkim and

Student scales Himalayan peak

A research scholar in the department of Ancient Indian History, Culture and Arts in Banaras Hindu University, Subhash Chandra Yadav, claimed to have climbed 19000 feet high DKD-II peak situated in Garhwal region of the Himalayas in the State of Uttaranchal.

Subhash Yadav is the first student of Banaras Hindu University, to have hoisted the national flag on 19000 feet high peak.

He achieved this feat in a month long advanced mountaineering course of Nehru Mountaineering Institute.

Subhash Yadav said that their group started climbing the peak at 2 am on October 3 and climbed the peak in 9 hours.

"It was a very difficult task to climb the peak as we had to face extreme adverse weather conditions. However, we continued till we achieved our goal", he said.

Cloning useful for brain damage treatment, says DNA scientist

Noted DNA scientist and director of the Centre for Cellular and Molecular Biology (Hyderabad), Padmashree Prof Lalji Singh said that human cloning was useful in various applications. He was delivering the keynote address on ‘bioethical, issues of genomic research and cloning, during a day-long workshop on Bioethics at the Mechanical Engineering Department of Institute of Technology on 18 December. Malaviya Centre for ethics and Human Values had organized the workshop.

Prof Lalji Singh said, human cloning could be used for producing stem cells for treatment of damage in brain and also producing a reservoir of spare parts “Besides, human cloning was also useful in disorder of blood cells, bone cells, cartilage cells, liver cells and skin cells etc.,” he said.

He said human cloning could help in understanding the process of ageing. He also discussed in detail about various applications of cloning of animals. “Animals on the verge of extinction could be multiplied by cloning,” he added.

“Therapeutic cloning presents new scientific prospects. This includes studying development of anomalies and determine which treatment would be the most appropriate,” he said. He also talked about using transgenic animals for production of pharmaceuticals and Xeno-transplant (growing pig with human genes for organ transplant).

Talking about ethics in biology, Prof Singh raised various questions such as - should we tell the patient and/or his/her family members about genetic predisposition to diseases, health insurance for those who are at genetic risk, employability of those who are genetically predisposed (at risk) to certain diseases.

He said ethics were required in biology but it was still under consideration as to what should be actual face of such ethics. Emeritus Professor at Zoology Department of BHU Padmashree Prof M S Kanungo presided over the lecture.

Coordinator of Malaviya Centre for Ethics and Human Values and Director of Institute of Technology, Prof S N Upadhyay delivered the welcome address whereas Prof A N Tripathi spoke about the concept of the centre. Prof R S Dubey established the theme of the workshop.



James Princep had beautifully highlighted Banaras: Kejariwal

In his address the chief guest and Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Panjab Singh praised Dr. Kejariwal’s lecture and highlighted the contributions of Bharat Kala Bhawan. He stressed the need for conserving the cultural heritage. Citing the example of recently held History of Art convention in Lucknow, he said that such meet should also be organized at Bharat Kala Bhawan, Prof. Singh also inaugurated the temporary exhibition series. “The Winter” at the same place. 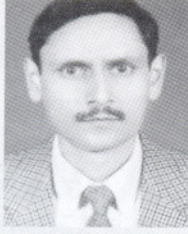
Mineralogical Association Meeting

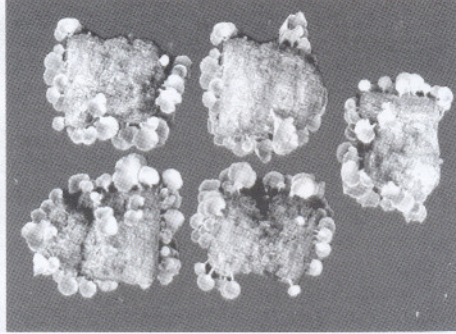
ऋतुरंग में बिखरी इन्द्रधनुषी छटा

भूमिहीनों के लिये मशरूम की खेती एक वरदान



आज किसानों का कृषिभूमि क्षेत्रफल घटता जा रहा है, इसका कारण है घर परिवार का बटवारा एवं बढ़ती जनसंख्या, बहुत से ऐसे किसान हैं जिनके पास भूमि नहीं के बराबर है परन्तु खेती करने की इच्छा रखते हैं। कृषि भूमि को खरीदने के लिये लाखों रूपयों की जरूरत पड़ती है जो किसानों के लिये मुश्किल होता जा रहा है। अब इन किसानों को निराश होने की जरूरत नहीं है क्योंकि एक ऐसी खेती को विकसित किया जा रहा है जिसकी खेती करने के लिये कृषि भूमि की जरूरत नहीं बल्कि कच्चे-पक्के घर या घास-फूस का छप्पर एवं धान-गेंहू का भूसा और मशरूम के बीज की जरूरत पड़ती है। मशरूम वैज्ञानिक आर.सी.राम के अनुसार मशरूम की खेती कृषि भूमिहीन किसानों के लिये वरदान है। मशरूम की खेती चाहे वह किसान हो या व्यवसायी, गांव का रहने वाला हो या शहर का पढ़ा लिखा हो या अनपढ़, अमीर हो या गरीब, सभी लोग कर सकते हैं। बस जरूरत है मशरूम की खेती से सम्बन्धित जानकारी एवं प्रायोगिक ज्ञान और मशरूम का बीज

जो काशी हिन्दू विश्वविद्यालय के कृषि विज्ञान संस्थान में कवक एवं पादप रोग विज्ञान विभाग में आर.सी.राम से सम्पर्क करके प्राप्त कर सकते हैं। इनके द्वारा किये गये मशरूम का आर्थिक विश्लेषण के आधार पर एक कुन्तल सूखे भूसे से 80-100 किग्रा तक मशरूम उगा सकते हैं जो लगाये गये लागत का तीन गुना आमदनी है।

यदि प्रति वर्ग मीटर क्षेत्रफल में फसलों का उत्पादन और मशरूम के उत्पादन में तुलना की जाय तो मशरूम उत्पादन कई गुना अधिक होगा। एक सर्वेक्षण के अनुसार लगभग 80 किग्रा मशरूम प्रतिवर्ग मीटर क्षेत्रफल में उगाया जा सकता है परन्तु अनाज दो किग्रा से भी कम प्राप्त होता है यदि उत्पादन की कीमत को देखा जाये तब भी बहुत बड़ा अन्तर है क्योंकि बाजार में मशरूम 50 रूपये प्रति किग्रा की दर से बिकता है जबकि अनाज 15 रूपया से भी कम दर पर बिकता है।

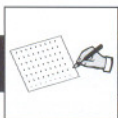
