Prof. H.C. Nainwal and Dr. A. K. Tripathi, Member of the Executive Council, attended the meeting through video conferencing. Prof. Ashim Kumar Mukherjee, Member of the Executive Council could not attend the meeting. Dr. Abhay Kumar Thakur, Finance Officer, Banaras Hindu University attended the meeting as Invitee.

At the outset, the Vice-Chancellor and Chairman of the Executive Council extended a warm welcome to the Hon'ble Members of the Executive Council and expressed his gratitude to them for their help and guidance.

The Agenda items were then taken up.

ECR 199**ITEM 1**

CONSIDERED confirmation of Minutes of the Executive Council Meeting held on June 23, 2020 (adjourned) and scheduled again on July 15, 2020.

The Minutes of the Executive Council meeting held on June 23, 2020, were circulated to the Hon'ble Members of the Executive Council vide email dated 17.08.2020 for their comments / suggestions thereon.

Prof. Anand Mohan, Dr. A. K. Singh, Prof. Bachcha Singh, Prof. A. P. Pandey, Prof. H.C. Nainwal and Dr. A. K. Tripathi members, Executive Council have sent their comments / suggestions in response to the above. However, no comments have been received from Prof. A. K. Mukherjee and Prof. R. N. Mishra.

The Executive Council considered the comments of the Hon'ble members on the drafts minutes of the Executive Council meeting held on June 23, 2020 (enclosed with the agenda) and after deliberations, the following was decided:

1. The statement regarding absence of Dr. Neeraj Tripathi, Registrar of the University during the consideration of item no. 20 be removed from page 1 and placed at the beginning of the item no.20.
2. In the item no.6 the word "Displeasure" may be shown in the advisory.
3. The word "Assistant Professor" in the second paragraph of resolution at item no.9 be corrected as "Associate Professor". Similarly in the last but one paragraph of the resolution of ex-agenda 6 the word "Associate Professor" be corrected by the word "Assistant Professor".

The Executive Council resolved to confirm the minutes with the aforesaid corrections.

RESOLVED THAT the minutes of the Executive Council Meeting held on June 23, 2020 (adjourned) and scheduled again on July 15, 2020, be confirmed with the aforesaid corrections.

**ECR 200
ITEM 2**

CONSIDERED confirmation of the Minutes of the meeting of the Executive Council held by circulation vide email dated July 31, 2020 and August 16, 2020.

The Registrar informed that the Academic Council in its meeting held on 27.07.2020 by circulation resolved vide its resolution on Item No. 2 to approve the recommendations of the Faculty of Medicine of its meeting of 16.12.2019 which also included starting of a certificate course in the Geriatric Medicine in addition to other courses. However, while recording the minutes of the Academic Council the approval for starting a certificate course in Geriatric Medicine was inadvertently left out. This should be included in the minutes accordingly.

The Registrar further informed that while drafting the Academic Council resolution at point no. 2 of its meeting dated 08.08.2020, it was mentioned that the questions should be so framed that the answer can be written by a student in three A4 size pages (single side) or in maximum 350 words. The phrase **or in maximum 350 words** should have been **with maximum 350 words**. It should therefore be corrected accordingly.

RESOLVED THAT the Executive Council meeting held by circulation vide email dated July 31, 2020 and August 16, 2020, be confirmed with the aforesaid correction in the minutes of the meeting of the Academic Council held on 27.07.2020 and 08.08.2020 respectively.

**ECR 201
ITEM 3**

CONSIDERED the orders of the Vice-Chancellor regarding confirmation of teachers and Group 'A' Officers of the University.

The Executive Council noted that the appointment of teachers as well as Group 'A' Officers is made by the Executive Council on probation for one year and on successful completion of probation, they are confirmed on their respective posts under the orders of the Vice-Chancellor who is authorized to do so by the Executive Council (ECR 29 of 1977). Due process of confirmation had been followed before passing order for confirmation of teachers and Group 'A' Officers of the university listed in Annexure-3 of the agenda.

RESOLVED THAT the orders of the Vice-Chancellor for confirmation of teachers and Group 'A' Officers of the University as per Annexure-3 of the Agenda, be approved.

CONSIDERED the decisions of the Investment Committee for investing funds of Banaras Hindu University on 06.08.2020.

RESOLVED THAT the decisions of the Investment Committee for investing funds of Banaras Hindu University on 06.08.2020 as per Annexure-4 of the Agenda, be approved.

ECR 203

ITEM 5

CONSIDERED the recommendations of Selection Committees for appointment / promotion of Teachers in different departments / units of the University.

The recommendations of Selection committees kept in sealed covers were placed in the meeting of the Executive Council.

The Vice-Chancellor informed the Executive Council about the letter dated 25.08.2020 from Ministry of Education, Govt. of India which permits recruitment of only Statutory posts and the posts related to the management of Covid-19 i.e. Doctors, Nurses, Lab Technicians etc. through online mode (**Annexure-5A**). Accordingly, the recruitments on the vacant teaching posts of the Faculty of Medicine and Faculty of Dental Sciences only have been made. On the issue of whether all the teachers and staff of all the departments of these faculties are engaged in the hospital of IMS, BHU for Covid-19 management, the Medical Superintendent of Sir Sunderlal Hospital (SSH), IMS gave a certificate that faculty members, senior residents, junior residents, nurses and technical staffs of all the departments of Institute of Medical Sciences are being deployed in COVID management services (**Annexure-5B**). Considering the certificate given by the Medical Superintendent, SSH, the Executive Council decided to open the envelopes containing recommendations of selection committees for appointment / promotion of teachers pertaining to the departments of IMS, BHU whose interviews were held through online mode, in terms of the aforesaid directions of the Ministry of Education vide its letter dated 25.08.2020.

Prof. Anand Mohan, Member, Executive Council as also other members raised the issue of promotion as Senior Professor under CAS in the Faculty of Medicine and Faculty of Dental Sciences, IMS. The members pointed out that the qualification followed in recruitment and promotion of teachers in the Faculty of Medicine and Faculty of Dental Sciences, IMS are different than the qualification for recruitment and promotion of teachers in other disciplines. The qualification for teachers in the Faculty of Medicine and Faculty of Dental Sciences, IMS does not require a Ph.D. degree for appointment as per MCI/DCI norms. Here MD/MS or MCH/DM in concerned speciality or superspeciality is the qualification for appointment as teacher. In the CAS scheme of UGC supervision of two Ph.D. is a mandatory requirement for promotion as Senior Professor. Hence it needs clarification from UGC as to whether supervision of some MD/MS or DM/MCH theses could be taken as equivalent to supervision of a Ph.D. thesis for promotion as Senior Professor of teachers in the Faculty of Medicine and Faculty of Dental Sciences, IMS. It may also be clarified from the UGC whether co-supervision of Ph.D. thesis may also be regarded as supervision of Ph.D. thesis for the purpose of promotion as Senior Professor under CAS. Moreover, the UGC Regulation, 2018 puts a cap of 10% of the total vacancies of Professor for appointment as Senior Professor through direct open selection whereas there is no cap on promotion as Senior Professors under CAS. The Executive Council after considering the aforesaid facts decided to seek clarification of UGC on the aforementioned points and not to make promotion as Senior Professor in Modern Medicine till the clarification is received.

RESOLVED THAT the recommendations of Selection Committees for appointment / promotion/reemployment of Teachers in different departments / units of IMS, Banaras Hindu University, be approved as per Annexure-5C of the Minutes.

Resolved further that a clarification from UGC be sought on the aforementioned points regarding promotion as Senior Professor under CAS and the recommendations for promotion as Senior Professor be not considered till such time.

**ECR 204
ITEM 6**

CONSIDERED the recommendation of PPC of IMS made at its meeting dated 21.09.2019 vide agenda item no.3 of the Minutes of the meeting of Policy & Planning Committee of the Institute of Medical Sciences, Banaras Hindu University held on 21.09.2019.

The Executive Council noted that the teaching positions were sanctioned by the UGC specifically for the Trauma Centre and Mahamana Centenary Superspeciality Complex respectively of IMS, BHU. Therefore, while affiliation of these teachers with the concerned specialties in the departments of IMS, Banaras Hindu University may be considered for academic purposes but they will not form part of the departments and would remain part of the concerned centre / complex only. However, all such propositions may first be considered by the Governing Body of the IMS and then be brought to the Executive Council.

RESOLVED THAT the matter be first placed before the Governing Body of the IMS and then be brought to the Executive Council.

ECR 205
ITEM 7

CONSIDERED the order of the Vice-Chancellor while approving the Minutes of the meeting of the Standing Committee of the School Board, Banaras Hindu University held on 20.07.2020.

RESOLVED THAT the order of the Vice-Chancellor passed while approving the Minutes of the meeting of the Standing Committee of the School Board, Banaras Hindu University held on 20.07.2020, be approved for implementation of the reservation to OBC-NCL class students in admission to the CHBS, CHGS and RSV as per the KVS norms.

ECR 206
ITEM 8

CONSIDERED the implementation of ERP system in the functioning of the University.

The Executive Council noted with great appreciation that the Banaras Hindu University has been able to complete its ERP system for automation of its financial, administrative, academic and general administration through the TCS by the generous support of TATA Trust. This is a remarkable achievement considering the size, diversity and complexities of functional domains of Banaras Hindu University. The generous support of TATA Trust in funding this project and the constant and dedicated work of TCS in completing it are praiseworthy and must be acknowledged with a sense of gratitude.

The efforts of the University administration in garnering support and cooperation of the TATA Trust and TCS in the development of the ERP for BHU and the herculean task of its

implementation in the University of this size is indeed commendable. The efforts of the Vice-Chancellor and the Registrar of the University are highly appreciable. This will not only bring about efficiency, accuracy, transparency, prompt action in the administrative functioning of the University but will also save a lot of University's fund in the engagement of man power for performing the administrative work manually which has become increasingly hard to get sanction for from UGC. The yeoman services of the Registrar in bringing about this systemic change and improvement in the work culture in the University and his organizational capabilities are highly appreciable and the Executive Council puts it on record.

RESOLVED THAT the generous support and cooperation of TATA Trust and TCS for funding and developing the ERP system for Banaras Hindu University be acknowledged with a sense of gratitude and the feelings of the Executive Council be communicated to the Chairman of TATA Trust and the Director, TCS. TATA Trust may be requested to support the development of software modules for students' life cycle and the left over portion of finance and HRMS that is fee collection and Estate Management so that the entire cycle is complete.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the ERP system shall be implemented in the University in its administrative, financial and accounting, academic and general functioning and all the functions available on the ERP system shall be used for this. The ERP system shall be the authorized system of working in the University and each employee of the University shall use this system

mandatorily for the aforesaid functions and for one's all personal matters related to the above.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the documents, data, reports etc. generated by the ERP system shall be treated as valid and authentic documents, data, reports etc. of the Banaras Hindu University.

RESOLVED STILL FURTHER THAT the efforts of the Vice-Chancellor and the yeoman services of the Registrar of the University in this endeavor are appreciated and commended; the Executive Council puts this on record.

ITEM 9**

CONSIDERED the decisions of the Investment Committee of the Banaras Hindu University held by circulation on 19.08.2020 for obtaining of the Legal Entity Identifier (LEI) Code Registration in the name of the Banaras Hindu University.

RESOLVED THAT the recommendations of the Investment Committee of the Banaras Hindu University held by circulation on 19.08.2020 for obtaining of the Legal Entity Identifier (LEI) Code Registration in the name of the Banaras Hindu University, be approved.

**ECR 208
ITEM 10**

CONSIDERED the proposal of UPPCL for installation of one more 132/33KV, 40 MVA transformer alongwith bus section Isolator & Breaker, construction of another 01 No. 33KV bay and to lay the 33KV underground cable from this bay through BHU's residential colonies.

The Executive Council noted that to improve the condition of power supply in the campus a project "Improvement of Power Supply" was initiated in BHU Campus. Consequently the 132KV BHU substation was constructed by BHU at their own land in collaboration with Power Grid Corporation of India Ltd. as per terms of approval for construction of 132KV substation on loop-in & loop-out (LILO) basis vide letter ref. No. 1605/ETCV/132KV.S/S BHU dated 14.07.2005.

With the intention of providing smooth power to B.H.U. Campus through newly constructed 132 KV BHU Substation, Banaras Hindu University, a MoU was signed on 22.01.2009 between Banaras Hindu University, Varanasi and Uttar Pradesh Power Transmission Corporation Limited, Uttar Pradesh.

As per the terms of aforesaid MoU, BHU provided UPPTCL with a land of 36M × 91M adjacent to 132KV BHU substation on long-term lease basis vide Lease Deed dated 10.06.2009 in lieu of 15% supervision charges for installing their 1 No. 132/33KV, 40MVA substation in order to distribute their electricity outside & around BHU. Further the parties agreed upon to facilitate co-operation in various areas mutually. Accordingly, the Banaras Hindu University is regularly paying the O&M charges for Operation & Maintenance (O&M) of 132 KV BHU Substation being carried out by UPPTCL and BHU is also paying on monthly basis the protective load charges to PVVNL to the tune of 100% contract demand charges.

In the Mean time, the Banaras Hindu University have almost completed the execution of the roof top solar power project

both in main campus (4887 KWp for BHU main campus and 169.975 KWp at Kamachha campus) as well as in south campus (RGSC) (1157 KWp) & put them on operation for its use. Since the aforesaid solar power system has been dovetailed with the existing power system, the net metering system is now essentially required.

BHU is also planning to install 25 MWp solar power project at RGSC Barkachha, power generated from it shall be fed to the 132 KV grid and in lieu of energy fed to the 132 KV grid, BHU shall draw power from the electrical grid for their BHU main campus, Kamachha complex & RGSC, Barkachha as per requirement. Remaining power shall be sold to UPPCL on the actual unit consumption. Therefore net metering shall be installed for BHU inclusive of RGSC. UPPCL shall accord permission for it.

A meeting chaired by the Vice-Chancellor, Banaras Hindu University was held on July 30, 2020 to discuss on the proposals of U.P. Power Transmission Corporation Limited, Government of Uttar Pradesh for installation of one more 132/33KV, 40 MVA transformer alongwith bus section Isolator & Breaker, construction of another 33KV bay and to lay the 33KV underground cable from this bay through BHU's residential colonies. The decisions of the meeting are as under:

1. The construction works - 1. Installment of one more 132/33KV, 40 MVA Transformer along with bus section Isolator & Breaker at their allocated space in 132 KV BHU substation, 2. Construction of another 01 No.33 KV bay at 132 KV BHU substation in their allotted space for giving power supply to their upcoming Nagwa substation outside the BHU campus, must be restricted to

the allocated space given to UPPTCL as per stipulations laid down in the aforesaid long term Lease Agreement. No additional space will be provided on any account for obvious reasons. Hence, MoU & aforesaid lease deed shall have to be accordingly amended to incorporate the construction of additional 1 No. 40 MVA transformer after being duly vetted by BHU's legal cell.

2. Since the operation & maintenance (O & M) of UPPTCL/PVVNL's part of 132KV BHU substation including their 40MVA Transformer & associated 33KV bays are also being carried out by the same personnel, the O & M charges of 132 KV BHU Substation being carried out by UPPTCL and paid by BHU, be exempted.
3. Protective load charges being paid by BHU to PVVNL to the tune of 100% contract demand charges, be exempted.
4. Requirement to replace urgently the BHU's overhead LT distribution by underground power distribution in order to tide over the difficulties severely faced during the storms and rainy seasons, be incorporated in the ongoing IPDS scheme in Varanasi inclusive of all the related expenditure to be incurred thereon.
5. The net metering system to the roof top solar power project both in main campus (4887 KWp for BHU main campus and 169.975 KWp at Kamachha campus) as well as in south campus (RGSC) (1157 KWp), be provided at the earliest

The officers of UPPCL agreed to consider the request of Banaras Hindu University and take up the matter at appropriate levels to implement these.

The Executive Council further noted that although the land space of Banaras Hindu University is fast shrinking and the University is finding it difficult to get land for its own projects and therefore is not in a position to spare land for any outside

agency, yet as the request is for public purpose and the cable would be laid through the trench already constructed for laying the cables of MPMCC and Banaras Hindu University it could be considered provided the UPPCL also considers the genuine concerns of Banaras Hindu University as explained in forgoing note.

After detailed deliberations on the aforesaid issues the Executive Council resolved as under:

RESOLVED THAT the University may grant permission to the request of UPPCL in the public interest subject to the following:

- 3 (a) The construction works mentioned at point no.1 of the meeting mentioned above must be restricted to the allocated space given to UPPTCL as per stipulations laid down in the aforesaid long term Lease Agreement. No additional space will be provided on any account. Hence, aforesaid lease deed shall have to be accordingly amended to incorporate the construction of additional 1 No. 40 MVA transformer after being duly vetted by BHU's legal cell.**
- (b) Since the operation & maintenance (O&M) of UPPTCL/PVVNL's part of 132KV BHU substation including their 40MVA Transformer & associated 33KV bays are also being carried out by the same personnel, the O & M charges being paid by BHU as mentioned in point NO. 2 of the meeting above be exempted.**
- (c) Protective load charges being paid by BHU as mentioned in point No.3 of the meeting above be exempted.**
- (d) BHU's underground LT distribution as mentioned in clause No. 4 of the meeting above be incorporated in the ongoing IPDS scheme in Varanasi inclusive of all the related expenditure to be incurred thereon.**

(e) The net metering system for BHU inclusive of RGSC Barkacha, as elaborated in detail in the point No. 5 of the meeting above as well as for the future planned 25MW land based solar power plant be provided at the earliest.

CONSIDERED the order of the Vice-Chancellor regarding operationalisation of Treasury Single Account (TSA) system in the University w.e.f 01.10.2020 for release of Grants to the Banaras Hindu University through it.

**ECR 210
ITEM 12**

CONSIDERED the request of Survey of India, Uttarakhand to provide them a space of 25 Sq. Metre (5 m x 5 m) near SE Corner of Airstrip in the premises of the Banaras Hindu University for installing and operationalizing the CORS Stations and other necessary Co-operation / Co-ordination in establishing the structure for CORS Stations.

The Executive Council noted that the land space of Banaras Hindu University is fast shrinking as many new constructions have come up in the recent past and many new ones are planned in near future in the implementation of IoE Scheme. Hence, it would not be possible for the University to spare any land space to any outside agency for the purpose not connected with the objects of the University.

RESOLVED THAT the request of Survey of India, Uttarakhand to provide them a space of 25 Sq. Metre (5 m x 5 m) near SE Corner

of Airstrip in the premises of the Banaras Hindu University for installing and operationalizing the CORS Stations and other necessary Co-operation/Co-ordination in establishing the structure for CORS Stations, be regretted.

**ECR 211
ITEM 13**

CONSIDERED the sanction of creation of administrative and Non-Teaching positions in Centenary Superspeciality Complex, Sir Sunderlal Hospital, Banaras Hindu University.

RESOLVED THAT the proposal for the sanction of creation of administrative positions of Dy. Medical Superintendent (1), Assistant Registrar (1), Section Officer (3), LDC/Office Assistant (12), Sanitary Inspector (2) for Centenary Superspeciality Complex, IMS, Banaras Hindu University, be sent to the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India on the prescribed format as desired by them.

**ECR 212
Ex-Agenda-1**

Prof. Bachcha Singh, member, Executive Council invited the attention of the house that the name of Banaras Hindu University has not be included in the name of Mahamana Pt. Madan Mohan Malaviya Cancer Centre established in sunder bagia campus of the University in collaboration with TATA Memorial Centre, Mumbai whereas as per the MoU signed between BHU and TMC the centre is an integral part of Banaras Hindu University.

In the light of the aforesaid it was resolved that the TATA Memorial Centre, Mumbai be requested to include the name

of Banaras Hindu University in the name of Mahamana Pt. Madan Mohan Malaviya Cancer Centre.

He also raised the issue of late confirmation of teachers and thereby denial of academic privileges of the University as a confirmed teacher including the enrolment of students for Ph.D. supervision. He also mentioned that many confirmed teachers particularly of RGSC are not allotted students for Ph.D. supervision by the concerned departments.

It was resolved that confirmations of teacher be done expeditiously following the due process and in case of delay such teachers be provided with the academic privileges as are available to a confirmed teacher. The concerned departments must ensure that every teacher desirous of supervising a Ph.D. student must be allotted a Ph.D. student to him/her for supervision. The violation of it by the departments would be viewed seriously.

ECR 213

Ex-Agenda-2

Dr. A.K. Singh, member, Executive Council drew the attention of the house to the fact that a large number of complaints about the functioning of the University and the teachers are received by the members. The other members also joined him in the aforesaid.

The house considered the matter and decided that it be left to the discretion of the hon'ble members to decide if such complaints/emails merit any cognizance or not and about the course of the action on these emails/representations

accordingly. Complaints having merit may be sent to the University.

ECR 214

Ex-Agenda-3

Prof. Anand Mohan, member, Executive Council raised the issue of a complaint against Prof. Saurabh Singh, Professor of Trauma Orthopedics, Trauma Centre, Banaras Hindu University of alleging false claims and submitting false documents in his application form for promotion as Professor under CAS. Further Prof. Anand Mohan also submitted details of the complaint. The Vice-Chancellor informed the house that on receipt of such a complaint and Inquiry Committee was constituted to inquire into the facts of the allegations which had submitted its report to him. However, the person against whom the allegations were made informed him that the Inquiry Committee did not call him in person to give his version of the facts and clarify the allegations which was against the natural justice. Vice-Chancellor then took legal opinion of the legal cell and based on the opinion had constituted another committee to inquire into the facts of the case giving the accused a fair opportunity of explanation and defending himself. The details submitted by Prof. Anand Mohan will be sent to the inquiry committee. The report of the committee would be placed before the Executive Council.

In the light of the above it was decided that the committee be asked to complete its inquiry and submit its report expeditiously and the entire matter be then brought before the Executive Council for its consideration.



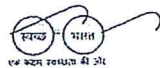

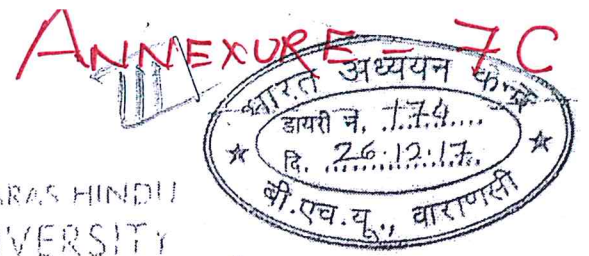

जैसा कि नियम निर्धारित है कि भारत अध्ययन केंद्र के सेन्टेनियल चेयर प्रोफेसर को नियमानुसार पांच वर्ष का कार्यकाल प्रदत्त है किन्तु प्रो. कमलेश दत्त त्रिपाठी, प्रो. युगल किशोर मिश्र एवं प्रो. राकेश कुमार उपाध्याय को चार वर्ष का कार्यकाल ही अभी तक दिया गया है। उपर्युक्त तीनों चेयर प्रोफेसर के चार वर्ष का कार्यकाल नवंबर-दिसंबर 2020 में विभिन्न तिथियों पर समाप्त हो रहा है। शेष एक वर्ष का कार्यकाल बढ़ाया जाना अपेक्षित है और इस सन्दर्भ में विश्वविद्यालय की कार्यकारिणी के द्वारा प्रस्ताव पारित है। इन प्रस्तावों में पहले चरण में दो वर्ष का कार्यकाल देने की बात कही गई है और दूसरे चरण में तीन वर्ष का कार्यकाल एक साथ देने का प्रस्ताव है।

कृपया चेयर प्रोफेसर की उम्र व अन्य परिस्थितियों को देखते हुए इस सन्दर्भ में सहानुभूति पूर्वक विचार कर निर्णय लेने की कृपा करें।



TO CONSIDER the Report of the Fact Finding Committee constituted to enquire into the charges levilled against Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit, Professor, Department of Veda, Faculty of Sanskrit Vidya Dharm Vigyan, B.H.U.

NOTE

Dr. Indu Singh, Reader, Deptt. of English, Raja Harpal Singh P.G. College, Singramau, Jaunpur lodged a complaint dated 05.02.2011 and 15.02.2011 that Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit passed his 10th Class and Purva Madhyama both in the year 1982; Intermediate and Uttar Madhyama both in the year 1984 simultaneously. Also an anonymous complaint dated nil addressed to Registrar, BHU was received in his office on 18.03.2011 from the Vice-Chancellor's Office for maintaining conducive teaching atmosphere in the department as was prevailing earlier which has been disturbed by Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit.

The Vice-Chancellor, BHU, ordered on 03.06.2011 to constitute an Inquiry Committee of the nature of preliminary Fact Finding consisting Prof. R.P. Singh, Director, Institute of Agricultural Sciences, the chairman and Sri Ajay Kumar, Assistant Registrar, University Works Department, the Secretary vide notification No. R/V7CS/HD-SVDV/11-12/504-507 dated 21.06.2011 **(Annexure-9A)** to inquire into the complaint dated 15.02.2011 of Dr. Indu Singh, Raja Harpal Singh PG College, Sigramau, Jaunpur against Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit, Reader, Department of Veda, Faculty of SVDV, BHU.

In the meantime Prof. R.C. Panda, the Dean, Faculty of SVDV vide letter No. SVDV/2011/205 dated 25.06.2011 **(Annexure-9B)** informed the Vice-Chancellor that during the headship of Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit there were disturbances in the Department regularly between the Head and the Faculty members and even the then Rector's efforts could not settle the

matters. Due to the behaviour of Dr. Dixit, his research scholar Mr. Udai Bharati changed his Supervisor to another faculty member. Dr. Dixit did not forward the application of Dr. Upendra Kumar Tripathi to attend Refresher Course at H.P. University, Shimla. Not only this when the higher authorities of the University allowed Dr. Tripathi to attend the Refresher Course, he directly wrote letter to the Academic Staff College, H.P. University. Due to this, the University had to again send an explanation to the Director, UGC-Academic Staff College, H.P. University that the application of Dr. Tripathi to attend the Refresher Course was forwarded on the orders of the Vice-Chancellor.

Dr. Sunil Katyayan, Asstt. Prof., Department of Veda made a complaint dated 08.07.2011 (**Annexure-9C**) that Dr. Dixit directed the Office staff not to receive letters from Dr. Katyayan and also Dr. Dixit created new problems daily.

Ms. Mamata Mehra, JRF, Department of Veda vide her letter dated 18.07.2011 (**Annexure-9D**) and another research scholar, Department of Veda vide his letter dated 18.07.2011 (**Annexure-9E**) lodged a number of complaints against Prof. Hareeshwar Dixit.

Dr. Upendra Kumar Tripathi, Asstt. Professor, Department of Veda vide his letter dated 19.07.2011 made complaint about mental torture and insult by Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit.

The Vice-Chancellor, BHU, ordered on 03.06.2011 to re-constitute the Fact Finding Committee consisting of Prof. H.C.S. Rathore, Dean, Faculty of Education, the Chairman, Prof. S.C. Lakhotia, Emeritus Professor, Department of Zoology, a Member, Prof. Manu Lata Sharma, Head, Department of Sanskrit, a Member and the Deputy Registrar, (Admin.-Teaching), the Member Secretary vide notification No. AB/8-P-53/54744

dated 23.03.2013 (**Annexure-9F**) to inquire into the complaint of the Dean, Faculty of SVDV dated 03.12.2012 against Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit, Professor, Department of Veda, Faculty of SVDV, BHU regarding his non-cooperation in conducting examination and his reply dated 07.02.2013 thereon. The Committee could not submit its report and in the meantime Prof. H.C.S. Rathore joined Central University of South Bihar as its Vice-Chancellor. The Vice-Chancellor, BHU then re-constituted the Fact Finding Committee vide notification No. R/V&CS/11-12/2016/524-528 dated 24.10.2016 (**Annexure-9G**) consisting of Prof. Manjeet Chaturvedi, Dean, Faculty of Social Science, the Chairman, Prof. H.N. Prasad, Library and Information Science a Member and Assistant Registrar, Institute of Agricultural Sciences as the Member Secretary to enquire into the various pending complaints against Prof. Hareeshwar Dixit, Department of Veda, Faculty of SVDV.

The aforesaid Committee vide letter No. R/Dev/AR/FFC-Dr.Dixit/2017-18/49424 dated November 17, 2017 (**Annexure-9H**) submitted its report. However, since the findings of the committee were not specific on each points of the complaint the Chairman, Fact Finding Committee was again requested to submit the report along with specific findings/conclusion at the earliest. In response to this the Committee vide letter No. R/Dev/AR/FFC-Dr. Dixit/2017-18/52483 dated December 26/5, 2017 has submitted its specific findings in the case of Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit, Department of Veda, Faculty of SVDV, BHU.

The findings interalia include the following:

1. **Complaint dated 05.02.2011 and 15.02.2011 of Dr. Indu Singh, Reader, Deptt. Of English, Raja Harpal Singh P.G. College, Singramau, Jaunpur regarding Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit simultaneously passing 10th Class and Purva Madhyama and Intermediate and Uttar Madhyama.**

Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit in his written statement accepted that he simultaneously appeared and passed 10th Class examination of U.P. Board and Purva Madhyama of Sampurnanand Sanskrit University in 1982 and Intermediate examination of U.P.

Board and Uttar Madhyama of Sampurnanand Sanskrit University in 1984 (Page 44 to 46 of Dr. Dixit's statement).

- 2. Anonymous complaint dated nil addressed to Registrar, BHU received in his office on 18.03.2011 from the Vice-Chancellor's Office.**

As it was an anonymous letter the Committee could not enquire into the authenticity of it.

- 3. Letter No. SVDV/2011/205 dated 25.06.2011 of the Dean, SVDV regarding internal bickering in the Deptt. Of Veda.**

As per the letter of Prof. R.C. Panda, the Dean, Faculty of SVDV and the statement and documents submitted by Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit it was established that during the headship of Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit there were regularly disturbances in the Department between the Head and the Faculty members and even the then Rector's efforts could not settle the matters .

Due to the behaviour of Dr. Dixit, his research scholar Mr. Udai Bharati changed his Supervisor to another faculty member.

Dr. Dixit did not forward the application of Dr. Upendra Kumar Tripathi to attend Refresher Course at H.P. University. Not only this when the higher authorities of the University allowed Dr. Tripathi to attend the Refresher Course, he directly wrote letter to the Academic Staff College, U.P. University (Page 61 of Dr. Dixit's statement). Due to this the University has to again send explanation to the Director, UGC-Academic Staff College, H.P. University that the application of Dr. Tripathi to attend the Refresher Course was forwarded on the orders of the Vice-Chancellor (Page 57 of Dr. Dixit's statement).

- 4. Complaint dated 08.07.2011 of Dr. Sunil Katyayan, Asstt. Prof., Department of Veda.**

To the complaint that Dr. Dixit directed the Office staff not to receive letters from Dr. Katyayan, Dr. Dixit stated that the letters are received in Dean's Office and he has no control over them,

Regarding attendance register, Dr. Dixit stated that as there are no office staff for the Deptt. Of Veda, as per practice the attendance register is under the custody of the Head. He further stated that Dr. Katyayan and Dr. Tripathi used to come late and pressurize him to allow tout their signature in the register.

As the attendance register was under the control of the Head further evidence is needed to substantiate the complaint of Dr. Katyayan.

- 5. Letter dated 18.07.2011 from research scholar, Department of Veda.**

As it was an anonymous letter no enquiry could be made.

- 6. Complaint dated 18.07.2011 of Ms. Mamata Mehra, JRF, Department of Veda.**

From the documents submitted by Ms. Mehra in support of her complaint it is clear that there is substance in her complaint.

Dr. Dixit tried to establish his innocence by submitting documents where he forwarded or took action on the letter on the same date. All these documents pertain to a single candidate regarding submission of thesis (Pages 118 to 123 of Dr. Dixit's statement). If Dr. Dixit could have submitted similar documents in respect of Ms. Mehra or other students then the Committee would have believed him.

This indicates that Dr. Dixit needs to be bias free towards some of the faculty members and their research scholars.

7. Complaint dated 19.7.2011 of Dr. Upendra Kumar Tripathi, Asstt. Professor, Department of Veda.

As Dr. Upendra Kumar Tripathi did not submit his written statement or any other supporting document to the committee, the committee could not arrive at a conclusion.

आदरणीय महोदय,

आपके निर्देशानुसार वेद विभाग के सम्बन्ध में आख्या प्रस्तुत कर रहा हूँ।

प्रो० हरीश्वर दीक्षित दिनांक 9 अगस्त, २०१० को विभागाध्यक्ष का कार्यभार ग्रहण किया। इससे पूर्व प्रो० हृदयरंजन शर्मा (जो अभी सेवानिवृत्त हुए हैं) उसी विभाग के अध्यक्ष के रूप में अनेक वर्षों तक कार्यरत थे। उस समय प्रो० हरीश्वर दीक्षित, डॉ० उपेन्द्र त्रिपाठी, डॉ० सुनील कात्यायन (सहायक प्रोफेसर), प्रो० शर्मा जी के साथ मिलकर वेद विभाग की शैक्षिक एवं भौतिक प्रगति के लिये सौहार्दपूर्ण वातावरण में सतत प्रयास करते थे।

परन्तु दुर्भाग्य की बात यह है कि जब से प्रो० दीक्षित अध्यक्ष का कार्य देखने लगे तब से उस विभाग के अध्यापक, छात्र एवं स्वयं अध्यक्ष महोदय अशान्ति के वातावरण में कार्य कर रहे हैं। अध्यापक, छात्र एवं विभागाध्यक्ष भी एक दूसरे पर आरोप-प्रत्यारोप करते रहते हैं और शिकायत पत्र भी माननीय महोदय के साथ-साथ माननीय रेक्टर महोदय एवं मेरे पास भेजते रहते हैं। इस सम्बन्ध में वेद विभाग में शान्ति स्थापित करने हेतु हमने अनेक बार विभाग में बैठकर विभागाध्यक्ष तथा सभी अध्यापकों को शान्ति के साथ अध्ययन-अध्यापन एवं शोध करने की सलाह दी। एक बैठक में वेद विभाग के सेवानिवृत्त अध्यापकों को भी आमंत्रित किया था। उन्होंने भी सबको समझाया। बैठक में सौहार्दपूर्ण वातावरण स्थापित करने की सहमति बनती थी, परन्तु दूसरे ही दिन पुनः विभागाध्यक्ष की कार्यप्रक्रिया से असन्तुष्ट अध्यापक एवं छात्र शिकायत प्रेषित करते थे।

माननीय रेक्टर महोदय भी कई बार वेद विभाग में सौहार्दपूर्ण वातावरण स्थापित करने का प्रयत्न किया। एक बार विभाग में आकर सबको समझाये एवं कईबार अपने कार्यालय में बुलाकर भी उन्होंने विभागाध्यक्ष एवं अध्यापकों को समझाया। परन्तु अद्यावधि सन्तोषपूर्ण वातावरण विभाग में परिलक्षित नहीं हो रहा है।

शोधछात्र असन्तुष्ट हैं। उनकी शिकायत है कि विभागाध्यक्ष महोदय शोध समिति में प्रेषित प्रगति-पत्र की प्रति (शोधार्थी की प्रति) छात्रों को नहीं देते हैं। मैंने भी विभागाध्यक्ष से न देने का कारण पूछा तो उन्होंने कहा कि आर्डिनेन्स में शोधछात्र को प्रगतिपत्र की प्रति देने का प्रावधान नहीं है। परन्तु पूरे संकाय में सभी विभागाध्यक्ष प्रगतिपत्र की एक प्रति शोधछात्र को भी देते हैं।

इसी प्रकार डॉ० उपेन्द्र कुमार त्रिपाठी के कथनानुसार उन्होंने रिफ्रेशर-कोर्स करने के लिए अनुमति प्राप्त करने हेतु वेद विभागाध्यक्ष जी को आवेदन-पत्र दिया था, परन्तु विभागाध्यक्ष जी ने उसे स्वीकार नहीं किया। इसके पश्चात् डॉ० त्रिपाठी ने रिफ्रेशर-कोर्स करने के लिए अनुमति प्रदान करने हेतु माननीय रेक्टर महोदय को पत्र देते हुए उसकी प्रतिलिपि अधोहस्ताक्षरी को भी दी। माननीय रेक्टर महोदय ने डॉ० त्रिपाठी के पत्र को यथोचित संस्तुति प्रेषित करने हेतु मेरे पास भेज दिया। मैंने उक्त पत्र को वेद विभागाध्यक्ष के पास आवश्यक संस्तुति प्रदान करने हेतु दिनांक २.६.२०११ को भेज दिया। वेद विभागाध्यक्ष ने आज तक डॉ० त्रिपाठी के आवेदन पत्र को संस्तुति या अन्य कोई टिप्पणी के साथ वापस नहीं किया। अतः मैंने अध्यापक हित को ध्यान में रखकर उनके आवेदन पत्र को यथोचित कार्यवाही हेतु माननीय रेक्टर महोदय के पास प्रेषित कर दिया।

इस प्रकार माननीय रेक्टर महोदय एवं मैं अभी तक विभाग में शान्ति के लिये प्रयास करते आ रहे हैं परन्तु हमें सफलता प्राप्त नहीं हो पा रही है। आज भी ऐसी ही शिकायत लेकर अध्यापक एवं छात्र आ रहे हैं। विभागाध्यक्ष भी विभागीय अध्यापकों के असहयोग की शिकायत लेकर आते हैं।

अतः माननीय महोदय से निवेदन है कि वेद-विभाग में शान्ति स्थापित करने हेतु यथोचित कार्यवाही करने की महती कृपा करें।

महोदय !

गतवर्ष 9 अगस्त 2010 को प्रो. हरीश्वर दीक्षित जी के वेदविभागाध्यक्ष बनने के बाद से ग्रीष्मावकाश जून 2011 पर्यन्त विभागाध्यक्ष जी द्वारा नित नई नई समस्याएं मानसिक उत्पीड़न के साथ दी जाती रही, जिनका अभी तक कोई समाधान नहीं निकल पाया है । ये समस्याएं निम्न हैं -

1. वेद विभागीय बैठकों में वेदविभागाध्यक्ष (प्रो. हरीश्वर दीक्षित) जी द्वारा अपने मनमुताबिक निर्णयों पर हस्ताक्षर करने का दबाव डालना, तथा न कहने पर भावी कार्यों (अवकाशादि लेने) में अड़ंगा लगाने की धमकी देना ।

3. प्रायः अहम बैठकों की पूर्व में सूचना-प्रति न देना ,अपितु जब-कभी भी रजिस्टर पर बैठक की तत्काल सूचना उतार कर बैठक करने के बहाने घण्टों - घण्टों लम्बी जिरह (बहस) करना ।

4. प्रायः इस तरह की नित नई नई समस्याएं खड़ी करना वेदविभागाध्यक्ष जी की आदत बन गई है जिसके तहत वे छोटी -छोटी बातों पर जबर्दस्ती हस्ताक्षर कराने तथा अपनी सम्मति वाले वाक्यों को लिखने के लिए हमें बाध्य करते हैं ।

5. उपरोक्त विषयों से अतिरिक्त और भी अन्यान्य ऐसे कारण हैं जिनसे प्रार्थी मानसिक रूप से अत्यंत उत्पीड़ित है जिस कारण से अध्ययन -अध्यापन तो प्रभावित होता ही है स्वास्थ्य में भी गिरावट आती है ॥ माननीय महोदय! उपरोक्त कारणों से विभाग में अविश्वास एवं भय का माहौल व्याप्त है जिस कारण चाटुकारिता की प्रवृत्ति बढ़ रही है तथा विभाग झूठे आरोपों का गढ़ बन रहा है अतः आपसे विनम्र निवेदन है कि विभागीय वातावरण को स्वच्छ बनाने में , हमको संरक्षित करने तथा नूतन सत्र 2011-2012 के सुचारु रूप से चलवाने में विशेष रूप से ध्यान देने की कृपा करें तथा गतवर्ष की भांति इस सत्र में होने वाली समस्याओं का समय-पूर्व समाधान भी करने की कृपा करें ।

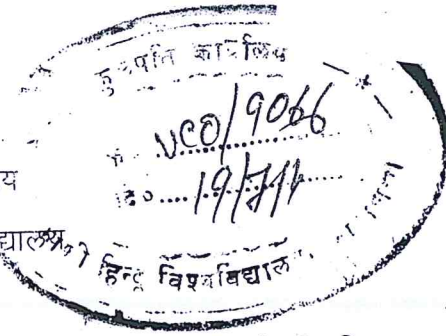

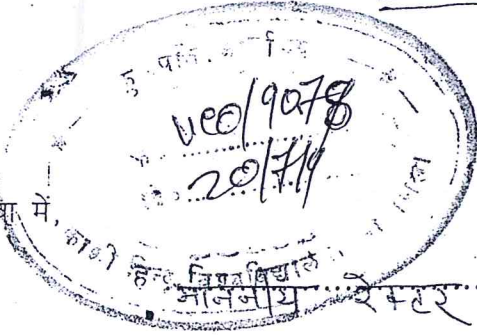

MANJEET CHATURVEDI, DEAN, FACULTY OF SOCIAL SCIENCES, TO ENQUIRE INTO THE VARIOUS PENDING COMPLAINTS AGAINST PROF. HAREESHWAR DIXIT, DEPARTMENT OF VEDA, FACULTY OF SANSKRIT VIDYA DHARMA VIGYAN

Vide notification No. R/V&CS/11-12/2016/524 dated 24.10.2016 of the Dy. Registrar (Vigilance & Confidential Section) a Fact Finding Committee has been reconstituted to enquire into the various pending complaints against Prof. Hareeshwar Dixit, Department of Veda, Faculty of S.V.D.V. The composition of the Fact Finding Committee is as follows :

Later the Chairman also received papers related to the case. From these papers it is clear that an inquiry committee of the nature of preliminary fact finding consisting of the following to enquire into the complaint dated 15/02/2011 of Dr. Indu Singh, Raja Harpal Singh PG College, Sigramau, Distt. Jaunpur against Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit, Reader, Department of Veda, Faculty of S.V.D.V. was constituted vide notification No. R/V&C/HD-SVDV/11-12/504 dated 21st June, 2011:

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From the correspondence made available to this committee it appears that this committee did not submit its report.

Vide letter No. R/V&CS/HD-SVDV/2013-14/ dated 30.04.2013/03/05.2013 the Fact Finding Committee was reconstituted to enquire into the complaints against Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit. The composition of the committee is as follows :

1.	Prof. H.C.S. Rathore, Dean, Faculty of Education	Chairman.

It appears this committee also did not make any progress in the matter.

Gist of the Complaints :

Complaint 1 : One Dr. Indu Singh, Reader, Deptt. of English, Raja Harpal Singh P.G. College, Singramau, Distt. Jaunpur in his complaint dated 5.02.2011 addressed to the Vice-Chancellor, BHU complained that Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit, Reader, Deptt. of S.V.D.V. and applicant to the post of Professor in the same Deptt. did his High School in the year 1982 and Intermediat in the year 1984 from U.P. Board. Simultaneously he appeared in Purva Madhyama in the year 1982 and Uttara Madhyama in the year 1984 from Sampurnanand Sanskrit Vishwavidyalay, Varanasi. He complained that appearing in two different board examinations in the same year is against rules. Therefore, he requested to enquire into the matter and take action against him. In support of his claim he submitted Purva Madhyama and Uttar Madhyama marksheets of Sampurnanand Sanskrit Vishwavidyalaya and Tabulation register of High School and Intermediate examinations of U.P. Board wherein the name of Hareeshwar Dixit appeared.

Complaint 2 : It is an 'anonymous' letter without any name and signature. In this letter the complainant complained that due to Dr. Dixit the name of the Department of Veda, which was once revered by all, is now coming into news due to various disputes. He further complained that Dr. Dixit is harassing the students by not signing on the documents by citing his inability due to personal problems or busy in other works etc. He never comes to Department in time causing problem in signing the attendance register by the time give by him, but later he marks in the attendance register the research scholars/ teacher as absent. He always

says that no officer can interfere in his work, including Rector and Vice-Chancellor.

Complaint 3 : This complaint was made by Prof. R.C. Panda, the then Dean, Faculty of S.V.D. to the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor on 25.06.2011. In this Prof. Panda complained that Prof. Hareeshwar Dixit took over as Head of the Department of Veda on 1st August, 2010. Prior to that Prof. Hriday Ranjan Sharma was the Head and under his headship all the faculty members worked for the academic and infrastructure development of the Department. But, since Prof. Dixit took over as Head, neither the Head nor other faculty members could work peacefully. To maintain peace in the Department of Veda, he convened several meetings of all the faculty members of the Department and advised them to peacefully do the academic and research work. In these meeting, he also invited the retired teachers of the Department. In these meetings, all used to agree to maintain peace in the

Department but from the next day the Head, faculty members and students used to make complaints to him.

The Rector also tried several times to bring cordiality in the Department. Still the atmosphere in the Department is not peaceful.

The Research scholars are also not happy. They complain that the Head is not giving the copy of progress report passed in the DRC meeting. When he asked Dr. Dixit, he replied that there is no provision in the Ph.D. Ordinances.



Mr. Uday Bharati, Research Scholar belonging to SC category, who is working under him also complained against Dr. Dixit with copies to Dy. Registrar, SC/ST Cell and Vice-Chancellor. As per advice of the Vice-Chancellor the supervisor of Mr. Uday Bharati was changed in the DRC.

Further, Dr. Dixit did not forward the application of Dr. Upendra Kumar Tripathi for Refresher Course. In this connection Dr. Tripathi submitted a representation to the Rector. When the Rector sent the same to Dr. Panda for his comments, he sent it to Dr. Dixit. But Dr. Dixit did not return the same with his comments. Keeping in view the career of Dr. Tripathi, Dr. Panda forwarded his application to the Rector for necessary action.

In this way the Rector and Dr. Panda tried to bring peace in the Department of Veda but they could not succeed in their efforts.

Complaint 4 : Dr. Suinil Katyan, Asstt. Professor, Deptt. of Veda, vide his letter dated 8.7.2011, made a complaint to the Vice-Chancellor that Dr. Dixit is harassing him mentally. He complained that Dr. Dixit takes arbitrary decisions and pressurises him to sign in the meeting register. When he says 'no' to any order of Dr. Dixit, he threatens that in future he will create problems in taking leave etc.

He further complained that Dr. Dixit never accomplishes work easily, but avoids/delays/lingers and whenever anybody gives reply to him he makes complaint against him and forcefully takes the signature of the teachers present.



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He never gives prior intimation about meeting and whenever he likes he writes the meeting notice on the register and in the name of meeting continues arguing for hours together.


It became a habit of Dr. Dixit to create new problems everyday and for small things also forces the teachers to sign or to write things in his favour.

In addition to the above there are many things due to which Dr. Katyayan felt mental harassment and it is effecting his teaching and research and his health.

Complaint 5 : Complaint letter dated 08.07.2011 from Research Scholars of Department of Veda addressed to the Rector, BHU. This is also an anonymous letter. In this letter the research scholars complained that when they approach him to get signature on papers related to research he makes them run for several days. Whenever they want to say any thing he starts saying "Shut up", "Get out", "Who are you" and insults them. A meeting of the Research Scholars was held on 13.07.2011 and he compelled the scholars present in the meeting to write complaints against the scholars who were not present. On 14.07.2011 he gave a notice to the research scholars to give their explanation despite the fact that they informed orally and verbally that due to their participation in Veda Seminar they could not attend the meeting on 13.07.2017. On 16.7.2017 Dr. Dixit issued disciplinary notice against the research scholars and their supervisors and pressurized them to sign on it. In the name of office record, he asks the scholars again and again to submit photocopies of papers related to their research. If this continues for some more time they may become psychiatric patients and some may leave the University.

Complaint 6 : Ms. Mamata Mehra, Research Scholar, Deptt. of Veda vide her letter dated 18.07.2011 made a complaint to the Rector, BHU against Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit. She complained that though she was present in the Department on time, her attendance was crossed. To sign on any proforma relating to her research like 6 monthly progress report, contingency bill, scholarship bill, leave application etc., he makes her run to the Department several times. Sometimes he asks to bring the papers personally, some times to send through the supervisor and some times to send through the office. Though she follows his instructions then also he did not sign the papers. Pressurizes everyday to sign on one or the other notices, if refused to sign then will not allow to sign on the attendance register. Using these notices he creates mental stress to her. He asks to submit photocopies of the papers several times in name of office record. When opposed, he says why are you people getting so much contingency and scholarship. Whenever she requests for something, he uses foul language and insults her before the public. Further he says "I am the representative of the Vice-Chancellor and whatever I say is the rule, if you obey them then only I will do your work otherwise I will stop all your work". He did not accept the last one year's JRF Scholarship bill, last 6 monthly progress report, application for extension of research period and leave applications, even after several attempts and sending through the





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office. Further, he threatened that he will 'kill' and 'ruin' her life using his pen.

Complaint 7 : Dr. Upendra Kumar Tripathi, Sr. Asstt. Professor, Department of Veda made a complaint on 19.07.2011 to the Dean, Faculty of S.V.D.V. against Dr. Dixit.

On 9.7.2011, a committee was constituted to prepare time table and Dr. Tripathi was made its convener. In pursuance to that letter Dr. Tripathi requested for copies of last year's time table. The same was not made available to him. On 11.7.2011 Dr. Dixit called Dr. Tripathi to his room. When he went there Dr. Dixit put before him a notice register and asked him to sign. Dr. Tripathi asked for a copy of the notice but he refused to give him. Then Dr. Tripathi wanted to note the same on a paper, then Dr. Dixit snatched the register from him. When Dr. Tripathi asked him to give the register to sign in it he did not give it and said do whatever you like and meet whomever you want to meet.

PROCEEDINGS OF THE COMMITTEE


In the meeting held on 24.10.2016 it was decided to:-

1. Write a letter to the Principal, Raja Harpal Singh, P.G. College, Singer Mau, Jaunpur, where Dr. Dixit previously worked as Assistant Professor to provide copies of Certificates and Marksheets submitted by him.
2. Write letter to the UP Board to verify the Marksheets of 10th & Intermediate submitted by Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit.
3. To write a letter to the Controller of Examinations to verify the Purva Madhyamika & Utter Madhyamika Marksheets submitted by Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit.

In the meeting held on 21.11.2016 the following persons attended before the committee:

1. Dr. Upender Kumar Tripathi, Sr. Asstt. Professor, Department of Veda, Dr. Tripathi gave replies to the questions asked by the Committee members. The Chairman asked him to submit his statement in writing.
2. Dr. Sunil Katyayan, Assistant Professor, Department of Veda, Dr. Katyayan gave replies to the questions asked by the Committee members and submitted his statement in writing also.

In the meeting held on 25.11.2016, the following persons attended before the Committee:

1. Dr. Udai Pratap Bharati, Assistant Professor, Department of Veda, Dr. Bharati was examined by the Committee members and was asked to submit through written statement which he complied.
2. Dr. Mamata Mehra, Research Scholar (Present by PDF) Department of Veda. Dr. Mehra was examined by the Committee members and was asked to submit her written statement which she complied.

In the meetings held on 01.06.2017 Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit was asked to present before the Committee but he did not turn up. It was decided to call him again on 05.06.2017.


In the meeting held on 05.06.2017 Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit appeared before the Committee. After having a discussion, he was asked to submit his written reply to the questionnaire given to him. He requested to provide copies of the complaints to prepare his reply. It was decided to provide copies of the complaints received against him and was asked to submit his written reply by 15th June 2017.

On 15th June 2017 Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit requested to give him time upto June 30, 2017 to prepare the reply and submit the same.

In the meeting held on 20.06.2017 Prof. Chandrama Pandey, Dean, Faculty of SVDV appeared before the committee, replied to the questions asked and submitted his written statement also.

STATEMENTS:

1. **Dr. Upendra Kumar Tripathi** asked permission to send his written statement, but even after reminder did not submit the same.
2. **Dr. Sunil Katyayan** : Dr. Sunil Katyayan, stated that while Dr. Dixit was Head of the Department he used unparliamentarily language, he always used to threaten to issue notice, he used to say "get out", "mere kamare se bahar jao" etc. He pressurized the guest faculty member to sign on complaints against faculty members. He never used to give the time table on time and on demand he used to give the time table but after getting backdated signature. He used to change the time table without informing the faculty members. For giving CL or duty leave to attend seminar etc. also he used to dilly dally. If any teacher was absent for any reason he used to call on urgent meeting and used to note the teachers absence in the minutes/meeting register.
3. **Dr. Udai Pratap Bharati, Asstt. Professor** : Dr. Bharati was registered under Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit for his Ph.D. in Sept. 2009. After one year he changed his supervisor to Dr. Sunil Katyayan. He stated that Dr. Dixit used to create problems in the Departmental meetings which can be verified from the Departmental meeting registers.
4. **Dr. (Mrs.) Mamata Mehra, Research Scholar (Presently PDF)** : Dr. Mehra stated that during the headship of Dr. Dixit she faced many difficulties like harassment, insults and delays in forwarding her progress reports, Contingency bills etc. He never permitted or gave leave to attend academic activities like seminars and other educational Programmes.



Many a times, on timely attending the Department also, Dr. Dixit not allowed the research scholars to sign their attendance. During his headship all the research scholars were under tremendous stress and this effected their research. She submitted copies of same letter she wrote to various authorities in this regard.

5. **Dr. Chandrama Pandey, Dean, Faculty of SVDV:** Dr. Pandey did not gave any specific information. He stated that Dr. Dixit is suffering from some psychological problem that is why he submitted his resignation from the Headship.
6. **Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit:** Dr. Dixit submitted replies to the Seven questions posed to him by the Committee in 22 pages with enclosures (Total 178 pages).

Q.1. Regarding his first appointment in BHU

He joined the Department of Veda on 01.02.2009 as Reader in Vedic Research.

Q.2. Regarding his previous engagement-

He worked in Raja Harpal Singh P.G. College, Singramau, Jaunpur from 23 August, 1994 to 31st January, 2009 as Lecturer (Sanskrit), Reader and Associate Professor.


Q.3. Regarding passing 10th Class from U.P. Board and Purva Madhyama from Sampurnanand Sanskrit University in the same year and Intermediate from UP Inter Board and Uttar Madhyama from Sampurnanand Sanskrit University in the same year.

He replied that he has already given reply to the above questions to the Committee constituted under Prof. R.P. Singh, the then Director, I.Ag.Sc., B.H.U. He attached copies of the reply given to Prof. R.P. Singh. He further stated that after that he has not received any reply in the matter. He further stated that as per the then Rector Prof. B.D. Singh's decision the matter was closed.

Regarding complaint of Dr. Indu Singh, Dr. Dixit claimed that Dr. Indu (Prakash) Singh never complained against him and the complaint, copy of which was given to him, was not made by him. In this connection, he submitted a letter written by Dr. Indu Prakash Singh, Reader, Deptt. of English, Raja Harpal Singh PG College, Singaramau, Jaunpur. He further stated that the letter was a conspiracy by Dr. Upendra Kumar Tripathi and Dr. Sunil Katyayan against him.

Q.4. Regarding non-forwarding of application of Dr. Upendra Tripathi for attending refresher course

Dr. Dixit replied that Dr. Upendra Tripathi was given the responsibility to conduct Upakarma and Rishipuja and Dr. Tripathi applied for leave for the duration 13-15th Aug. 2011. He further stated that the Dean himself wrote on the application of Dr. Sunil Katyayan that "उपाकर्म विद्यालय का अत्यावश्यक कार्य है, वेद-विभागीय



अध्यापकों के अवकाश स्वीकृतिका अधिकार अध्यक्ष को है।” He further stated that the then Dean forwarded his letter in this connection (forwarding of application of Dr. Upendra Kumar Tripathi) addressed to the Hon’ble Vice-Chancellor and Dy. Registrar (Teaching) which indicates that the Dean also consented to his action.

Q.5. Regarding allegation of Dr. Sunil Katyayan that Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit mentally harassed him

Dr. Dixit stated that both Dr. Upendra Kumar Tripathi and Dr. Sunil Katyayan used to harass him with the help of the then Dean Prof. R.C. Panda. He further stated that there are allegations that Dr. Katyayan leaked the question paper of Department of Veda.

He never harmed Dr. Katyayan’s interest. As Head of the Department he forwarded his application for Refresher Course and he also helped him in his promotion from stage 1 to stage 2 of Assistant Professor.

Q.6. Regarding the complaint of Research Scholars that their progress reports etc. are not forwarded by him in time.

Dr. Dixit stated that he never delayed the progress reports and Scholarship bills of Research Scholars. Whereas the supervisor(s) used to forward the applications of the students late to the Head of the Department. He further stated that the students of Dr. Patanjali Mishra have no complaints whereas only students of Dr. Upadhyaya and Dr. Katyayan have complaints. He stated that Dr. Uday Pratap Bharati in his letter wrote “डॉ. दीक्षित से मेरी कोई शिकायत नहीं है और मैं इनके निर्देशन में शोध कार्य करना चाहता हूँ”. He stated that it is a preplanned conspiracy to remove him from Headship and prevent him from becoming Professor.

Q.7. Regarding providing further information, if any, which may help the fact finding committee

Dr. Dixit stated that he is an outsider. Therefore other faculty members could not accommodate him. The then Dean, Prof. R.C. Panda did not like his frank & straight forwarded behavior and developed a grudge against him. Prof. Hriday Ranjan Sharma, who was Head when Dr. Dixit joined, also did not like him. Therefore, all these persons formed a group and started harassing him.

Further he levelled various allegations against Dr. R.C. Panda, Dr. Chandrama Pandey and others.

Findings of the Committee :

- 1. Complaint dated 05.02.2011 and 15.02.2011 of Dr. Indu Singh, Reader, Deptt. Of English, Raja Harpal Singh PG College, Sineraman, Jaunpur regarding Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit simultaneously passing 10th Class and Purva Madhyama and Intermediate and Uttar Madhyama.**

As per the decision taken in the meeting of the enquiry committee held on 24.10.2016 a letter was sent vide No. IAS/AR/FFC-Dr.Dixit/2016-

17/143 on Nov. 22, 2016 to Dr. Indu Singh requesting him to present before the enquiry committee by Speed Post but the same was returned undelivered with the remarks "लेने से इन्कार किया".

But Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit attached a copy of letter dated 30.07.2017 from Dr. Indu Prakash Singh addressed to Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit (page 39 of reply), in reply to his letter dated 25.07.2017 (page 43 of reply) stating that he has not written any complaint against him. It is not clear why Dr. Indu Singh refused to take the letter sent by the Secretary of the Fact Finding Committee.

The Committee wrote another letter to the Principal, Raja Harpal Singh PG College, Singraman, Jaunpur, vide No. IAS/AR/FFC-Dr. Dixit/2016-17/1095 dated Nov. 10/11, 2016, but no reply was received from the Principal till date.

Regarding his passing both High School from UP Borad and Purvamadhyama from SS University in 1982 and Intermediate from UP Intermediate Board and Uttarmadhyama from SS University in 1984, he submitted a letter addressed to Regional Secretary, Secondary Education Board, Regional Office, Varanasi stating that due to his ignorance of rules he appeared in both the examinations, but he never used these Certificates and now he wanted to return the certificates and asked him to cancel the certificates (page 45). He also submitted an affidavit addressed to the Regional Secretary, Secondary Education Board, Regional office, Varanasi dated 14.02.2011, i.e., after the first complaint letter dated 05.02.2011 from Dr. Indu Singh.

2. Anonymous complaint dated nil addressed to Registrar, BHU received in his office on 18.03.2011 from the Vice-Chancellor Office.

As it was on an anonymous letter the Committee could not enquire into the authenticity of it.

3. Letter No. SVDV/2011/205 dated 25.06.2011 of Dean, SVDV regarding internal bickerings in the Deptt. Of Veda.

The Committee tried to contact the then Dean, SVDV, Prof. R.C. Panda, but he did not attend the meeting of the Committee. He is at present working as Vice-Chancellor of Maharishi Sandipani Vishwavidyalaya, Indore.

The present Dean, Prof. Chandrama Pandey attended before the committee on 20.06.2017 but he could not be of much help.

In the letter dated 25.06.2011, Prof. Panda informed that he convened many meetings to resolve the issue. He stated that during the meetings it appeared that the problems are solved and the faculty members will work in a harmonious manner. But on the very next day the teachers and students used to complain against Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit. Page No. 70, 71 and 78 of the reply submitted by Dr. Dixit corroborate this statement.

Prof. Panda in his letter further stated that the then Rector, Prof. B.D. Singh also convened several meetings of all the faculty members of Deptt of Veda to resolve the issues. But harmony between the faculty members could not be established. Dr. Dixit enclosed to his reply a copy of minutes of such meetings held on 15.09.2011 under the Chairmanship Prof. B.D. Singh, Rector wherein it was resolved to work in a congenial environment in future and rooms were allotted to the faculty members.


In his letter Dr. Panda also mentioned about complaint of Mr. Udai Bharati, Ph.D. Scholar against Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit. He further informed that as per the directives of Vice-Chancellor his supervisor was changed. In this connection Dr. Dixit in his statement (Page 09) stated that Dr. Bharati has written "डॉ. दीक्षित से मेरी कोई शिकायत नहीं है और मैं इनके निर्देशन में शोध कार्य करना चाहता हूँ, and it shows that the complaint against him (Dr. Dixit) was written by Mr. Bharati under the pressure of Dr. Upendra Kr. Tripathi and Dr. Sunil Katyayan. A perusal of the letter of Mr. Bharati dated 26.09.2011 (Page 124) and 06.09.2011 (page 125) reveals that Dr. Dixit misquoted Mr. Bharati and suppressed some of the information while quoting it. What Mr. Bharati wrote in his letters is quoted below :

"सादर निवेदन है कि अपरिहार्य कारणों से मेरे निर्देशक परिवर्तित हो गये। अब मुझे अपने पूर्व निर्देशक (सम्प्रति विभागाध्यक्ष) डॉ हरीश्वर दीक्षित से कोई शिकायत नहीं है और मैं उनके अन्तर्गत शोध कार्य करना चाहता हूँ।"

From this it could not be established that Mr. Bharati earlier complained against Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit under duress. Further, it shows that to take advantage, Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit can suppress and change statements according to his convenience.

Dr. Panda, in his letter dated 25.06.2011, mentioned about the case of Dr. Upendra Kumar Tripathi regarding his Refresher course. Dr. Panda mentioned that Dr. Dixit did not accept the application of Dr. Tripathi for attending Refresher Course. Therefore, Dr. Tripathi wrote a letter to the Rector requesting him to permit him to do Refresher Course with a copy to the Dean. The Rector has sent the letter of Dr. Tripathi to the Dean for necessary action and he sent the same to Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit, the then Head, Department of Veda for his comments. But Dr. Dixit did returned that paper to the Dean till 25.6.2011. Therefore, keeping in view the future of the teacher, he forwarded the application of Dr. Tripathi to the Rector for necessary action.

In this connection Dr. Dixit replied that to do Refresher course Dr. Tripathi has still time as he will be eligible for stage three after two and half years, so he can attend the refresher course later also. Further, an important faculty work, i.e. Upakarma and Rishipuja (to be held on Shraavan Purnima), was given to Dr. Tripathi. He further stated that Dr. Panda himself wrote on the leave application or Dr. Katyayan the following :

“उपाकर्म विश्वविद्यालय का अत्यावश्यक कार्य है, वेद विभागीय अध्यापकों के अवकाश स्वीकृति का अधिकार अध्यक्ष को है”।

A perusal of the letter dated 04.08.2011 of Dr. S. Katyayan (Page 59), on which Dr. Panda wrote his comments, reveals that again Dr. Dixit misquoted/ suppressed/ added certain words. The original comments of the Dean is given below:

“उपाकर्म विश्वविद्यालय का आवश्यक कार्य । विभागीय अध्यापकों की अवकाश स्वीकृति अध्यक्ष करते हैं। स्वीकृति के पहले आवश्यक कार्य को ध्यान में रखना आवश्यक है।”

Further, as Head of Department he cannot refuse to take any application. He should take the application, put his comments and send it to the higher authorities for necessary action.

Still further, when his superiors sent any letter for comments the Head should put his comments and return it to the authorities for taking a decision in the matter which he did not do in the case of Dr. Tripathi.

4. Complaint dated 08.07.2011 of Dr. Sunil Katyayan, Asstt. Prof. Department of Veda.

Dr. Sunil Katyayan in his statement before the committee reiterated his complaints. He also submitted a copy of time table given to him by the Head of Department and a copy of letter dated 24.09.2011 addressed to the Head indicating the difficulties faced by the students due to clash of classes. Dr. Dixit returned it in original with the remarks that classes of student are not hampered and instead of wasting time in writing unnecessary letters he should implement the decision of the Rector.

Regarding receiving of letters, Dr. Dixit stated that as there are no staff attached to the Head/Department of Veda, all the letters are received in the Dean's Office and he has not given any instruction to the Dean's office to not accept the letters. As the office is under the control of the Dean, and Prof. Panda has some grudge with him, he might have got complaints made against him in this regard. Therefore, the allegation of Dr. S. Katyayan that he directed the office not to take his letter is wrong.


In connection with the complaint that Dr. Dixit not allow them to sign their attendance, Dr. Dixit stated that Dr. Tripathi and Dr. Katyayan used to come late, and when advised to come timely they used to quarrel with him and threatened to see him removed from Headship.


Further they used to sign in the attendance register one day in advance. In support he submitted copy of attendance register where Dr. Tripathi signed a day prior (Page 111).

5. Letter dated 18.07.2011 from research scholar Department of Veda.

As it was an anonymous letter no enquiry could be made.




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
6. Complaint dated 18.07.2011 of Ms. Mamata Mehra, JRF, Department of Veda.

Smt. Mamata Mehra reiterated her complaints before the fact finding committee. She stated that during the Headship of Dr. Dixit she faced many Problems. Dr. Dixit used to strike her attendance in the attendance register, delayed in signing her progress reports, contingency bills etc. for months together. Many times he did not allowed her to sign in the attendance register though she came well in time. He refused to give leave or permission to attend various seminars and other educational programmes.

Dr. Dixit stated that during his Headship he never put hurdles to Research Scholars. He used to sign the progress reports etc. in time and as a proof he attached various papers related to one Mr. Vijay Kumar Sharma. He further stated that another Asstt. Professor, Dr. Patanjali Mishra and his research scholars have no complaints against him and he stated that this shows it is a preplanned conspiracy against him by Dr. Tripathi and Dr. Katyayan.

7. Complaint dated 19.07.2011 of Dr. Upendra Kumar Tripathi, Asstt. Professor, Department of Veda.

As stated earlier Dr. Tripathi had a discussion with the committee members. But he did not submit his written statement even after sending a reminder. So on this issue no questions were put to Dr. Dixit.

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**SPECIFIC FINDINGS IN THE CASE OF PROF. HAREESHWAR DIXIT,
DEPARTMENT OF VEDA, FACULTY OF SANSKRIT VIDYA DHARMA VIGYAN.**

1. **Complaint dated 05.02.2011 and 15.02.2011 of Dr. Indu Singh, Reader, Deptt. Of English, Raja Harpal Singh P.G. College, Singramau, Jaunpur regarding Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit simultaneously passing 10th Class and Purva Madhyama and Intermediate and Uttar Madhyama.**

Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit in his written statement accepted that he simultaneously appeared and passed 10th Class examination of U.P. Board and Purva Madhyama of Sampurnanand Sanskrit University in 1982 and Intermediate examination of U.P. Board and Uttar Madhyama of Sampurnanand Sanskrit University in 1984 (Page 44 to 46 of Dr. Dixit's statement).

2. **Anonymous complaint dated nil addressed to Registrar, BHU received in his office on 18.03.2011 from the Vice-Chancellor's Office.**

As it was an anonymous letter the Committee could not enquire into the authenticity of it.

3. **Letter No. SVDV/2011/205 dated 25.06.2011 of the Dean, SVDV regarding internal bickering in the Deptt. Of Veda.**

As per the letter of Prof. R.C. Panda, the Dean, Faculty of SVDV and the statement and documents submitted by Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit it was established that during the headship of Dr. Hareeshwar Dixit there were regularly disturbances in the Department between the Head and the Faculty members and even the then Rector's efforts could not settle the matters .

Due to the behaviour of Dr. Dixit, his research scholar Mr. Udai Bharati changed his Supervisor to another faculty member.

Dr. Dixit did not forward the application of Dr. Upendra Kumar Tripathi to attend Refresher Course at H.P. University. Not only this when the higher authorities of the University allowed Dr. Tripathi to attend the Refresher Course, he directly wrote letter to the Academic Staff College, U.P. University (Page 61 of Dr. Dixit's statement). Due to this the University has to again send explanation to the Director, UGC-Academic Staff College, H.P. University that the application of Dr. Tripathi to attend the Refresher Course was forwarded on the orders of the Vice-Chancellor (Page 57 of Dr. Dixit's statement).

4. **Complaint dated 08.07.2011 of Dr. Sunil Katyayan, Asstt. Prof., Department of Veda.**

To the complaint that Dr. Dixit directed the Office staff not to receive letters from Dr. Katyayan, Dr. Dixit stated that the letters are received in Dean's Office and he has no control over them,

Regarding attendance register, Dr. Dixit stated that as there are no office staff for the Deptt. Of Veda, as per practice the attendance register is under the custody of the Head. He further stated that Dr. Katyayan and Dr. Tripathi used to come late and pressurize him to allow to put their signature in the register.

As the attendance register was under the control of the Head further evidence is needed to substantiate the complaint of Dr. Katyayan.

5. Letter dated 18.07.2011 from research scholar, Department of Veda.

As it was an anonymous letter no enquiry could be made.

6. Complaint dated 18.07.2011 of Ms. Mamata Mehra, JRF, Department of Veda.


From the documents submitted by Ms. Mehra in support of her complaint it is clear that there is substance in her complaint.

Dr. Dixit tried to establish his innocence by submitting documents where he forwarded or took action on the letter on the same date. All these documents pertain to a single candidate regarding submission of thesis (Pages 118 to 123 of Dr. Dixit's statement). If Dr. Dixit could have submitted similar documents in respect of Ms. Mehra or other students then the Committee would have believed him.

This indicates that Dr. Dixit needs to be bias free towards some of the faculty members and their research scholars.

7. Complaint dated 19.7.2011 of Dr. Upendra Kumar Tripathi, Asstt. Professor, Department of Veda.

As Dr. Upendra Kumar Tripathi did not submit his written statement or any other supporting document to the committee, the committee could not arrive at a conclusion .
