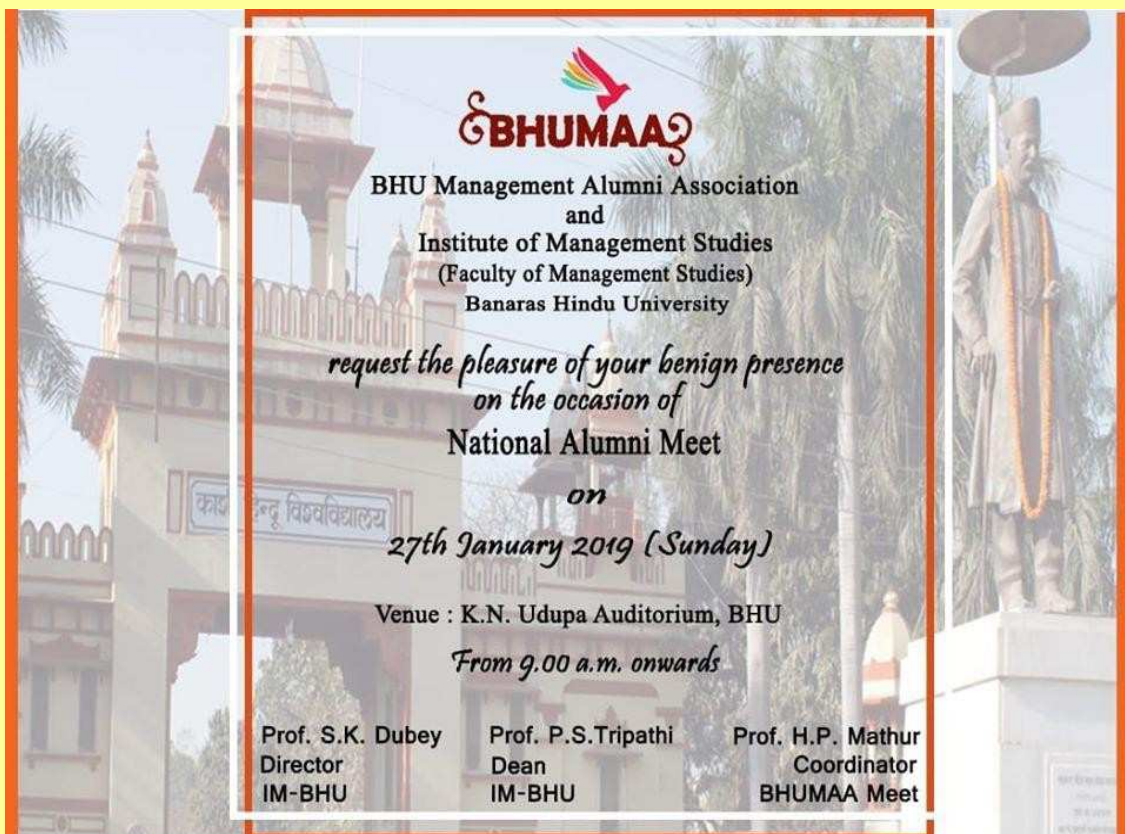

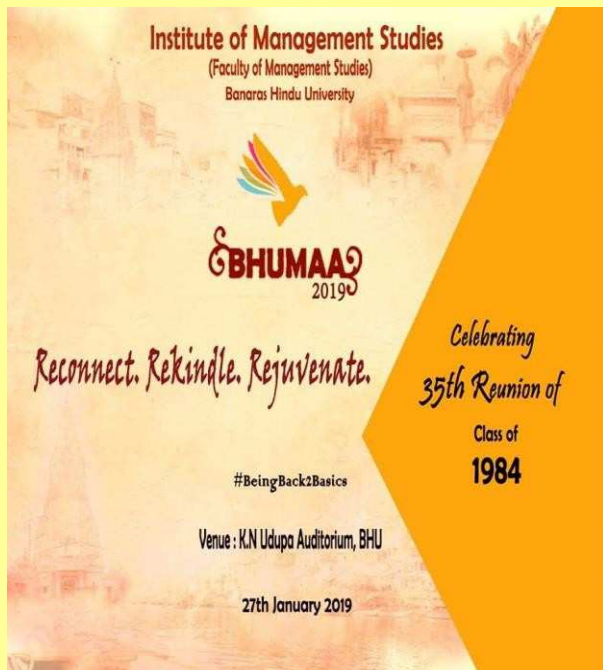

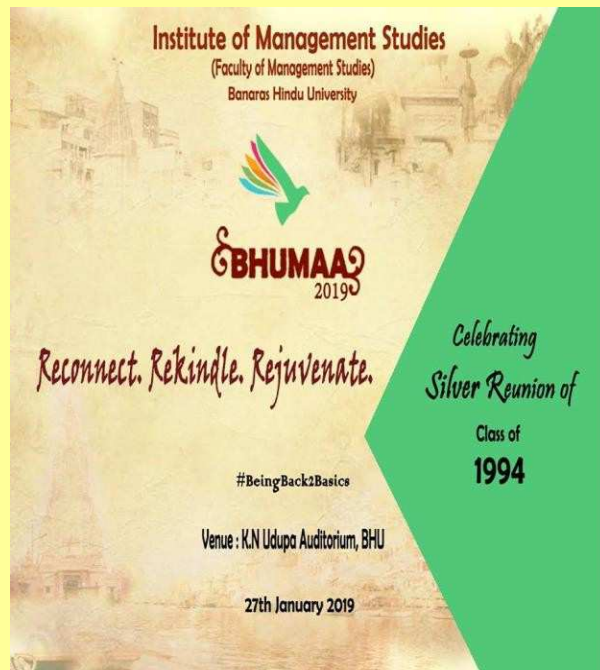
With mirth and laughter let's revive the good old times...

विदेशी आयात से घटेगी निर्भरता, वर्तमान में 750 मिलियन टन खपत

देश में खुलेंगी 50 कोयला खान

देश की ऊर्जा जरूरतों को पूरा करने के लिए हाल के वर्षों में तापीय ऊर्जाघरों की बड़ी संख्या में स्थापना की गई है। जिनके लिए देश में ही कोयला उत्पादित करने के साथ विदेश से भी आयात किया जाता है। पावर प्लांट्स की संख्या बढ़ने से विदेशी कोयले पर निर्भरता बढ़ती जा रही है। इसे देखते हुए देश के विभिन्न राज्यों में 50 नई कोयला खान खोली जाएंगी। रविवार को यह जानकारी कोल इंडिया लि. स्थित मैटेरियल मैनेजमेंट डिपार्टमेंट के पूर्व हेड एवं इंडियन इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ मैटेरियल मैनेजमेंट के राष्ट्रीय अध्यक्ष जीके सिंह ने दी। उन्होंने कहा कि देश में पचास नई खान खुलने के बाद विदेशों से कोयला आयात घटेगा।

अभी 650 मिलियन टन उत्पादन बीएचयू स्थित केएन उडप्पा सभागार में आयोजित 'भूमा' के स्वर्ण जयंती सम्मेलन में आए जीके सिंह ने दैनिक जागरण संग बातचीत में कहा कि देश में 650 मिलियन टन कोयले का उत्पादन हो रहा है। इसमें कोल इंडिया का 84 फीसद योगदान है। उत्पादन में

हर वर्ष कम से कम 10 फीसद वृद्धि चाहिए। कुछ वर्ष से स्थिति सामान्य नहीं है। इस कारण 130 मिलियन टन विदेशों से कोयला आयात हो रहा है।

माईस खुलने की प्रक्रिया तेज कोयला आयात पर निर्भरता देखते हुए सरकार ने अब बेहतर पहल की है। इसके तहत ओडिशा, झारखंड, मध्यप्रदेश और छत्तीसगढ़ में करीब 100 नए खान खोलने की योजना बनाई है। इसमें से 50 माईस खोलने की प्रक्रिया तेज हो गई है। बताया कि 12 खान तो दो साल के अंदर ही खुल जाएंगी। इसके बाद विदेशी कोयले पर से निर्भरता कम हो जाएगी। फिलहाल, करीब 750 मिलियन टन कोयले की खपत है।

इंडीआइ से भेजेंगे विदेशों में सामान वाराणसी : डीएचएल के हेड एवं बीएचयू प्रबंध शास्त्र संस्थान के पूर्व छात्र दिनेश्वर सिंह ने कहा कि भारत से सामान भेजने को जल्द इंडीआइ (इलेक्ट्रॉनिक डेटा इंटरचेंज) व्यवस्था होने वाली है। इसके तहत पांच लाख तक का सामान ऑनलाइन भेजा सकता है। बताया कि यह व्यवस्था एमएसएमई के तहत की जा रही है। वहीं डीएचएल द्वारा हर वर्ष बीएचयू से कम से कम दो छात्रों का करीब 11-11 लाख सालाना पैकेज में चयन किया जा रहा है।
