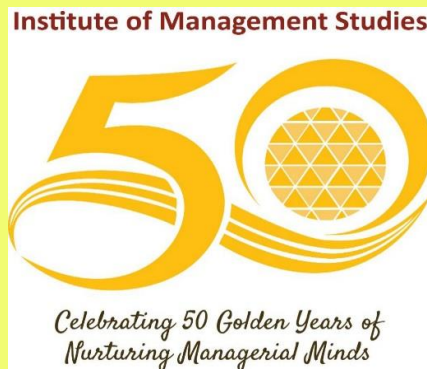

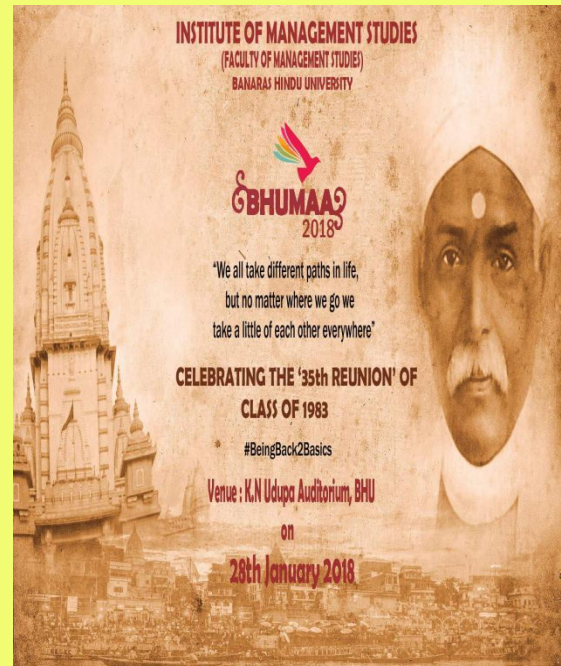
With mirth and laughter let's revive the good old times..

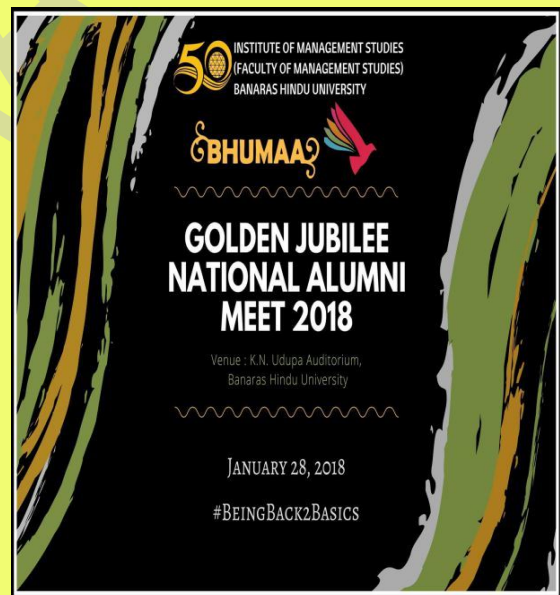
