Report of the sessions held on day 1 (22 January 2015)

The workshop started with the technical session by Ms. Renu Bohra, Director HR, DB Schenker, on "Managing self". He motivated the students to discover the inner-self. For that he added the students must learn to think deeply, listen more, speak less and learn with conviction.

The day concluded with the technical session by Prof. Furqan Qamar, Secretary General, AIU. Addressing the gathering he said, "Gen Y, or the 20-to-30 age group, today constitutes a major part of the country's workforce and will bring us tomorrow's leaders". According to him, tomorrow's leadership is based on vision and shared values. Moving ahead he said that leadership is nothing but extending your dream to the dreams of others. The event started with a welcome address by the Dean, Prof. R.K. Pandey. Prof. H.P. Mathur, Co-ordinator of University and FMS Placement Cells and Chief, Univ. Employment Information & Guidance Bureaudiscussed about the genesis of workshop. A vote of thanks was proposed by Prof. Deepak Barman, Former Dean, FMS, BHU. The sessions were deeply insightful, with students being enriched with a lot of knowledge and encouraged them to gear up for their career ahead. The Inaugural Session was conducted by Pallavi Thacker.

Report of the sessions held on day 2 (23 January 2015)

The two day workshop on "Mentoring Expectations and Developing Competencies in Gen-Y" being held in Faculty of Management Studies, Banaras Hindu University concluded with Mr. Terry O'Brien taking a session on "Steps to Competencies Today". He advised the students to take inspiration from others, but the journey of life has to be walked alone. Further he said, it is important to be a good follower to become a great leader. He motivated the students by saying that it was the "I" which is positive and not the inflated ego. He emphasized on the fact that life is an echo, and that what you give to people is what you get in return. He motivated the students by saying that one should work for one's self-image and that desire, work, attitude, goals and relationships were required to make a good self-image. "Be a workafrolic and not a workaholic", he added. This was followed by an interactive session where the queries of the students were answered.

The second session was by Mr. Amitabh Agrawal, Director, NIIT, Varanasi. He started the session by sharing with the students his experiences of his long association with the faculty and how his life changed with the learnings he got here. Speaking on the topic "Diversity: A Competitive Advantage" he said that the idea of diversity is sometimes misunderstood and undervalued in corporate settings. The final session of the workshop was taken by Mr. Deepak Gupta, Group Head-HR, Karvy on "Competencies in Gen-Y". "Knowing oneself was the key to success", he said.
