National Workshop on Model Curriculum Development for Management Studies

We are happy and proud to announce that the **Workshop on Model Course Curriculum Development for Management Studies** held in the Faculty
on June 25th, 2011, was quite successful. It was very well attended by eminent academics and industry professionals.

Actually the faculty decided to update/change the Course curriculum as per the contemporary requirements. For this the Dean, **Prof S K Singh** discussed the matter with the faculty and many suggestions came forth. It was then decided to form a Core Committee to work on the intricacies of a new course curriculum under the leadership of Prof R K Pandey, the other members being Dr Alok.Kr Rai, Dr Ashish Bajpai, Dr R K Lodhwal, Dr Abhijit Singh and Dr Amit Gautam.

This committee came forth with a very innovative curriculum where there are several choices for the students to select from in their optional areas. There is a set of Frozen Courses, which will be compulsorily studied by the students opting for a specific specialization and a set of choices from nine other papers.

This proposed curriculum underwent serious discussions at a series of Faculty level meetings to give it an initial structure. The results of the Faculty level exercise were sent to experts in the Corporate and Academic Sector and they have been invited to send in their suggestions.
