

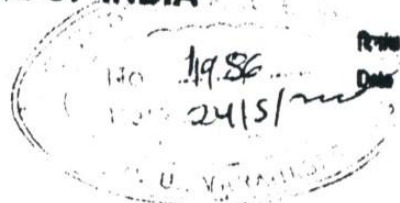

Subject: Starting of M.Ch (Surgical Oncology) course at Institute of Medical Sciences, BHU, Varanasi – Permission of Central Government – Regarding

Whereas, the Institute of Medial Sciences, Banaras Hindu University (BHU), Varanasi (U.P.) had started M.Ch (Surgical Oncology) in 2006 with one seat without any Letter of Permission from the Central Government under the provisions of the Indian Medical Council (IMC) Act, 1956 and Regulations framed thereunder;

And whereas, the Institute had subsequently taken admission against one seat in the said course;

And whereas, the Institute has been approaching the Central Government / Medical Council of India (MCI) for recognition of the course under Section 11(2) of IMC Act;

And whereas, the students who had taken admission in the said course over the years and have successfully passed have also been seeking an ex-post facto approval of Central Government for starting the course;

And whereas the MCI has stated that section 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 regarding permission to start / inczease in PG seats was introduced in 1993 and no course can be started after that without the permission of MCI / Central Government. The present course was started in the year 2006, without the permission of MCI / Central Government and hence cannot be recognised.

And whereas, the Institute of Medial Sciences, BHU, Varanasi (U.P.) being a Central Government institution is exempted from the application of provisions of section 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 and Regulations framed thereunder in respect of grant of approval for starting a new course of study under the provision of Explanation 1 under sub-section (1) of section 10A of the IMC Act, 1956;

Now therefore, the Central Government, after due consideration and in particular taking into view the interest of the students who have passed the course from the Institute since 2006, has decided to give its ex-post facto approval for starting of M.Ch (Surgical Oncology) course at the Institute of Medial Sciences, Banaras Hindu University (BHU), Varanasi (U.P.) with one (1) seat with effect from the actual starting of the course in 2006.

Subject: Banaras Hindu University - Recognition of DM(Cardiology) qualification for 1 seat in respect of students being trained at Institute of Medical Sciences, BHU, Varansi.

Sir/ Madam,

I am directed to state that the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee of this Council at its meeting held on 09/02/2016 considered the Council Assessor's Report (November, 2015) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of DM(Cardiology) qualification for 1 seat at Institute of Medical Sciences, BHU, Varansi granted by Banaras Hindu University and decided as under:-

"The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (November, 2015) and decided to recommend not to recognize DM(Cardiology) qualification for 1 seat granted by Banaras Hindu University in respect of students being trained at Institute of Medical Sciences, BHU, Varansi because of the following facts:-

1. Deficiency of faculty: (a) Asso. Prof.: 1.
2. The only Unit does not have Asso. Prof.; resultantly faculty complement is incomplete & it cannot be considered as PG Unit.
3. Dr. Vikas Aggarwal, DNB from non-teaching hospital not eligible to be appointed as Asst. Professor. Since, he has no teaching experience.
4. Dr. Geeta Subramanian, Professor & HoD worked in Government General Hospital, Chennai from 1987 to 1994 and this period cannot be counted as experience in Cardiology. Resultantly, her promotion is not as per Regulations.
5. Resultantly, there are only 2 Asst. Professors in the department.
6. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 01 seat after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the concerned Post Graduate Course. This is also clarified in the letter of permission granted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 issued for these seats, which reads as under:

"This permission for starting/ increase of seats in the above course and admission of students will be till such time the first batch of students admitted against the above course appears for the first final examination in the subject."

In case, the college authorities desire to submit compliance, same should be received in this office preferably within six weeks of issue of this letter but definitely, prior to next admission so that the matter of recognition can be finally decided. If no compliance is received within this period or compliance/ compliance verification is found unsatisfactory, it will result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course against the above mentioned seats."
