Recent Achievements (during 2015-16 in brief)

7. **New building for Deptt. of R.T. & R.M.**: A fully equipped new building became operational to facilitate cancer patients.
8. **New Building for Emergency OPD**: The 60 bedded new building having latest life saving equipments is ready for its operation which shall mitigate the congestion of present casualty OPD. With Ultrasound, X-Ray, Blood Investigation, Operation Theatre and Pharmacy will make the 100 bedded (60 new + 40 old) Emergency Service under one roof.



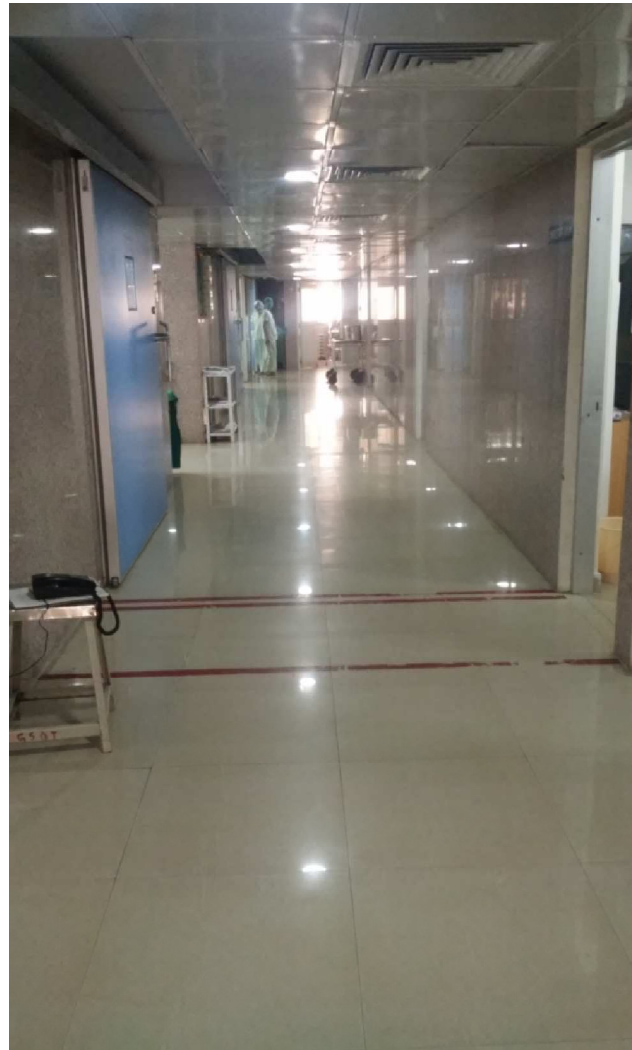
9. **I.C.U. Renovation**: The long pending work of I.C.U. renovation is being carried out on priority basis.

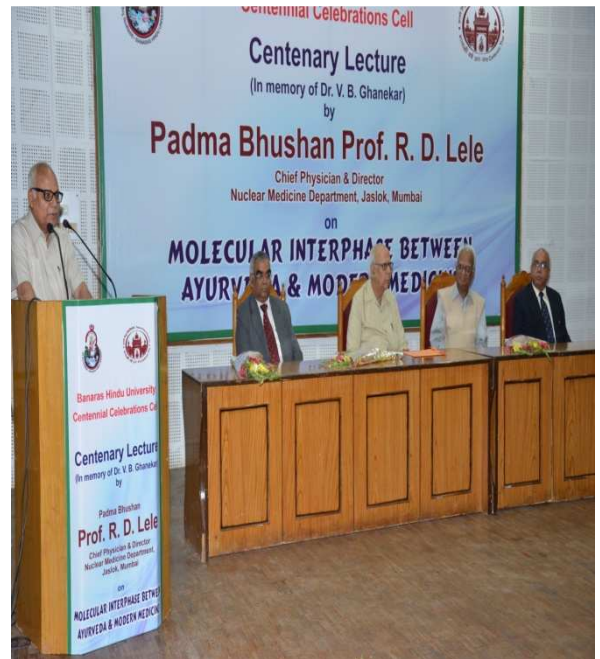

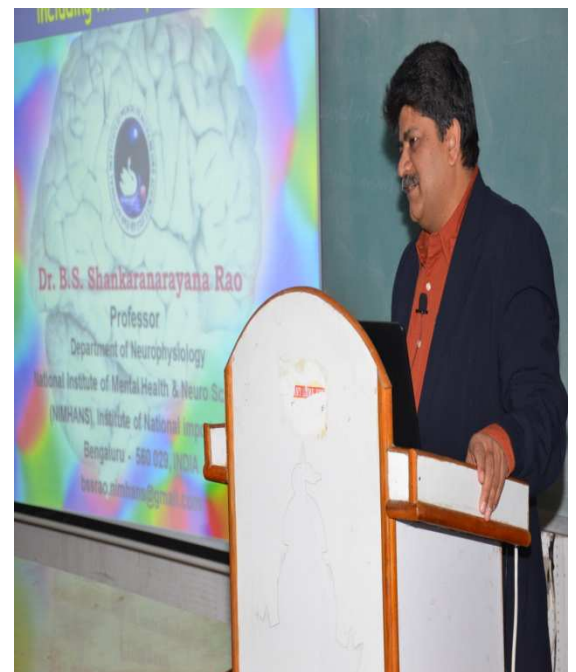
