MINUTES of the meeting of the Coordination Committee for MD/MS/MDS Registration 2018 held on February 2, 2018 at 12.00 Noon in the Committee Room of the IMS-BHU.

At the outset the Chairman welcomed the members and appraised the committee about the MD/MS/MDS registration for seeking admission in Institute of Medical Sciences, Banaras Hindu University. The following issues were discussed and approved by the committee.

The Committee noted that in the previous year the counselling for 50% All India quota was done at the level of Additional Director General, Medical Education, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India through Medical Counselling Committee and 50% of Internal (Institutional) quota seats was done by the Director General Medical Education, Uttar Pradesh.

The Committee also noted that during the admissions in the previous year, the Institute faced a number of writ petitions and representations. All NEET PG 2017 qualified candidates were eligible for left over Institutional MD/MS seats, irrespective of college, Institute or states as it is a Central Institute. But, the DGME UP had not done nationwide advertisement regarding this. Thus, many eligible NEET PG 2017 qualified candidates did not get an opportunity to apply for IMS, BHU due to lack of information. As a result, eleven MD/MS seats remained vacant and many deserving candidates have been robbed of the opportunity to pursue a Post Graduate course. This is a national loss, as Institute is struggling to increase MD/MS seat but PG seats of IMS, BHU remained vacant. A letter to this effect was sent to the Additional Director General – Medical Education, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India to consider allotting the Institutional PG (MD/MS/MDS) seats at his level as per the norms of Institute of Medical Sciences, BHU as has been practiced in earlier years or Permit the Institute of Medical Sciences, BHU to conduct separate counselling for Institutional PG (MD/MS/MDS) seats as per previous practices.

After deliberation, it was unanimously RESOLVED that the Additional Director General, Medical Education may be requested to allocate a separate portal to facilitate counselling and admission in MD/MS/MDS Courses (Session 2018-19) at Institute of Medical Sciences, Banaras Hindu University as was being done for
