
REQUIREMENT:

Experience, if any, along with Certificate/Marksheet/Caste Certificate/ No Objection Certificate etc. (original documents) are also required, **no separate call letter will be sent for appearing in the Interview. - 6) Candidates are advised to bring a self-addressed stamped envelope (of speed post value) along with application form.
- 7) Your appointment is purely on temporary basis for a period of six months at the first instance or till further orders if any whichever is earlier.
- 8) The candidate should have post graduate degree for Senior Resident in the parent subject from the MCI recognized Institution.
- 9) Incomplete applications will not be considered and will be REJECTED. The applicant will be solely responsible for it.
