## 6. FINANCIAL RESOURCES

### (A) University Finances

The University's finances are derived from the grants received from various funding agencies under projects and schemes, development grants from U.G.C. and Government of India. The Maintenance expenditure as well as Development expenditure are met by grants received from U.G.C. under "Non-Plan" and "Plan" respectively. The University own resources are generated by way of receipts from students fee, income from properties, dairy and agriculture farm, hospital Licence fee from shops, income from sale of Ayurvedic drugs, donation from other income generated by the University. According to the nature of funds, the University is maintaining its accounts under the following heads:

#### (a) General Fund ('R' Account)

The main source of funds available to the University for payment of pay and allowances, scholarships, working expenses on developments, maintenance of buildings, supporting services etc., consists of:

- i. Grants from the U.G.C.
- ii Internal Receipt
- iii Interest on Investments

The University is being funded by the Government of India through the University Grants Commission. This grant is also known as the Block Grant. The University's Maintenance Budget represents annual expenditure covering the following areas:

#### Capital Account

Library-Books and Journals, other capital (Building and Machineries), office equipments, teaching aids materials etc. The details of expenditure are classified as under:

#### Establishment

Pay and Allowances including additional D.A., retirement benefits, pension, commutation, gratuity, leave encashment, contribution to P.F. and other

allowances of teaching and non-teaching employees.

#### Non-Establishment

Scholarship and stipend, chemicals and laboratory expenses of the academic departments, maintenance of hostels, buildings, electric and water services, telephone, travelling allowances, liveries, stationery and printing, postage, maintenance of staff car, maintenance of auxiliary units, Press, Dairy Farm, Health Services, U.W.D., Horticulturist, maintenance of Hospital, students facilities including Sports Board, Sanitary and Support Services, Guest House Complex, Canteen and Cafeteria, Computer Centre, I.R.D.P., N.S.S. etc.

The University was facing financial crisis during the past few years due to non-release of adequate funds from the U.G.C./Ministry of H.R.D. as per the Budgetary provisions approved by the Finance Committee. Accordingly, the University had to restrict its expenditure under the non-establishment sector in order to maintain budgetary discipline and also keep the expenditure within the ceiling as fixed by the U.G.C. in the financial year.

from single entry accounting system, for the first time Annual Accounts and Balance Sheet for the financial year 2009-10 has been got prepared on double entry system as per GOI format and handed over to the Govt. Auditors for auditing.

The accounts of the University are annually

audited by the Principal, A.G., U.P. Allahabad on behalf of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India. In accordance with the Govt. of India instructions, the audited accounts of the University are required to be placed on the table of the Parliament by 31st December of the following year. of the Parliament by 31st December of the following year.
