- The participants are supposed to turn on their camera and microphone throughout the event and are supposed to adjust in a way their entire body language is clearly visible.

#### TURNCOAT

- Participant may use Hindi or English language but not both.
- The same participant has to deliver both constructive and rebuttal speeches.
- Topic will be given 10 minutes before, on the spot.
- Judgment will be based on content and database, language and grammar, contrast of presentation and representation skill etc.
- Only individual participation is allowed.

#### SHORT STORY WRITING (HINDI)

- Medium shall be Hindi only.
- Word limit: 4000 5000 words.
- Topic will be announced 48 hours in advance (Through App/Website or Social Media Platforms).
- Content may be typed or handwritten as convenient to the participants.
- Participant have to submit their content through google form or through email as instructed then.
- File format shall be in pdf only (clear and legible pdf content).

#### SHORT STORY WRITING (ENGLISH)

- Medium shall be English only.
- Word limit: 4000 5000 words.
- Topic will be announced 48 hours in advance (Through App/Website or Social Media Platforms).
- Content may be typed or handwritten as convenient to the participants.
- Participant have to submit their content through google form or through email as instructed then.
- File format shall be in pdf only (clear and legible pdf content).

#### SHORT STORY TELLING (HINDI)

- Medium shall be Hindi/English (can't be both) only.
- 3 themes/subjects shall be provided to the participants and they are expected to select anyone.
- Stories presented may be authentic or adapted. Plagiarism is not allowed.
- Stories presented must not be based on any sensitive issues like religion, caste, race, etc.
- Paper or screen reading is strictly prohibited.
- Judgement shall be based on content selection, language proficiency, presentation and expressions.
- The theme/subject for the event shall be provided 48 hrs in advance (Through App/Website or Social Media Platforms).
- The participant would be required to submit the contents of the story in writing to the JUDGES at the time of recitation through google forms or through Aakanksha email

#### SHORT STORY TELLING (ENGLISH)

- Medium shall be English/Hindi (can't be both) only.
- 3 themes/subjects shall be provided to the participants and they are expected to select anyone.
- Stories presented may be authentic or adapted. Plagiarism is not allowed.
- Stories presented must not be based on any sensitive issues like religion, caste, race, etc.
- Paper or screen reading is strictly prohibited.
- Judgement shall be based on content selection, language proficiency, presentation and expressions.
- The theme/subject for the event shall be provided 48 hrs in advance (Through App/Website or Social Media Platforms).
- The participant would be required to submit the contents of the story in writing to the JUDGES at the time of recitation through google forms or through Aakanksha email

#### EVENT RULES (FINE ARTS)

#### ON THE SPOT PAINTING

- Event will be conducted on the spot and participants are supposed to do the painting on the given subject.
- 12×18 inch OR A3 paper should be used for the purpose.
- Painting can be in oil, water, poster or pastel color.
- No wording except caption will be allowed.
- Participants have to submit their content through google form or through email as instructed then.
- File format shall be in pdf only (clear and legible pdf content).
- Blurred content shall not be accepted.

#### POSTER MAKING

- Event will be conducted on the spot and participants are supposed to do the painting on the given subject.
- 12×18 inch OR A3 paper should be used for the purpose.
- Participants have to submit their content through google form or through email as instructed then.
- File format shall be in pdf only (clear and legible pdf content).
- Blurred content shall not be accepted.

#### CARTOONING

- Theme for cartooning will be provided on the spot.
- 12×18 inch OR A3 paper should be used for the purpose.
- Participants have to submit their content through google form or through email within the provided time duration.
- File format shall be in pdf only (clear and readable pdf content).
- Blurred content shall not be accepted.

#### COLLAGE

- Event will be conducted on the spot and the theme shall be provided by the event in charge.
- 12×18 inch OR A3 paper should be used for the purpose.
- Collage has to be prepared from old magazines and newspapers.
- Topic will be announced 48 hours in advance (Thorough App/Website or Social Media Platforms).
- Participant have to submit their content through google form or through email.
- File format shall be in pdf or image file.
- Blurred content shall not be accepted.

#### EVENT RULES (DANCE)

#### FILM DANCE SOLO

- Dance based on Remixes are permitted.
- Dance based on classical film songs are not permitted.
- Judgment will be based on qualities like movement and expression.
- For audition round participants have to submit only 2 minutes dance video through google Forms, if video duration is more than 2 minutes only first 2 minutes will be trimmed for judgement.
- Participant's whole body and expressions should be visible throughout the video.
- Video should be recorded in LANDSCAPE (Aspect ratio 16:9) mode only.
- Quality of video should not be less than 720p (1280x720).

#### WESTERN DANCE SOLO

- Recorded music from Western films, albums, tracks or remixes are allowed.
- Dance based on Indian films/albums/remixes are not allowed.
- Judgment will be based on qualities like movement and expression.
- For audition round participants have to submit only 2 minutes dance video through google forms, if video duration is more than 2 minutes only first 2 minutes will be trimmed for judgement.
- Participant's whole body and expressions should be visible throughout the video.
- Video should be recorded in LANDSCAPE (Aspect ratio 16:9) mode only.
- Quality of video should not be less than 720p (1280x720).

#### CLASSICAL DANCE SOLO

- Film songs are not allowed.
- Judgment will be based on taal, selection of raaga, composition and general impression.
- For audition round participants have to submit only 45 seconds to 2 minutes video through google forms, if video duration is more than 2 minutes only first 2 minutes will be trimmed for judgement.
- The video must be recorded after 31st January 2022.
- Participant's whole body and expressions should be visible throughout the video.
- Video should be recorded in LANDSCAPE (Aspect ratio 16:9) mode only.
- Quality of video should not be less than 720p (1280x720).

#### THEATRE

#### MIMICRY

- Participants may mimic sound of machines, speech of well-known persons, animals or sounds heard in nature.
- It should be necessarily a cultured and pleasant piece of art.
- Medium of expression can be Hindi or English or both.
- Judgment will be based on qualities like variety of sound and voices imitated and presentation.
- For audition round participants have to submit only 2 minutes dance video through google forms, if video duration is more than 2 minutes only first 2 minutes will be trimmed for judgement.
- Participant whole body and expressions should be visible throughout the video.
- Video should be recorded in LANDSCAPE (Aspect ratio 16:9) mode only.
- Quality of video should not be less than 720p (1280x720).

#### MUSIC

#### FILM SONG SOLO

- Participants have to record a video of themselves while singing.
- Audio must be clear and their face properly visible at all times.
- The video must be recorded after 31st January 2022.
- For audition round participants have to submit only 45 seconds to 2 minutes video through google forms, if video duration is more than 2 minutes only first 2 minutes will be trimmed for judgement.
- Use of karaoke, backing tracks or instruments is not allowed in audition round, for final round use of karaoke is allowed.
- Audio cannot be edited, processed or altered after recording.
- No remix songs are permitted.





- Download 'Aakanksha ISc BHU' Android app from Google play store.
- Click on sign up to register yourself on the app.
- Enter your email ID (examination portal email/entrance exam email or any university registered email) and set your password.
- If you are currently a member of The Aakanksha Organizing Team then, select 'Organizing Team' and enter the provided referral code and click on the arrow button.


