WALK-IN-INTERVIEW FOR THE POST OF SCHOOL TEACHERS

In partial modification to the advertisement for Walk-in-Interview for the post of School Teachers on contractual basis for the session 2016-17 in the CHBS (K), CHGS (K), RSV (K) & Central Hindu School, RGSC, Barkachha, BHU, the essential qualification and age limit earlier advertised for the posts of TGT, TGT (Hindi-cum-English), TGT (Spoken English), TGT (Social Studies), TGT (Vyakaran, Sahitya, Jyotish & Veda) & PRT may be corrected to read as :

TGT:

E.Q.: (i) Second Class Bachelor's Degree in the relevant subject with not less than 50% marks from a recognized University with B.Ed. or its equivalent Degree duly approved by NCTE from a recognized University. (ii) Pass in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) in accordance with Guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose/ Teacher Eligibility Test (TET). (iii) Competence to teach both through Hindi & English medium.

TGT (Hindi-cum-English):

E.Q.: Graduation in English & Hindi both subjects with 50% marks and B.Ed. with 50% marks with CTET in accordance with Guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose/TET.

TGT (Spoken English):

E.Q.: :: Graduation in English with 50% marks and B.Ed. with 50% marks with 06 months Diploma in Spoken English with CTET in accordance with Guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose/TET.

TGT (Social Studies):

E.Q.: Graduation with atleast 50% marks in any two subjects from the History, Geography, Economics and Political Science of which one must be either History or Geography and B.Ed. with 50% marks with CTET in accordance with Guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose/TET.

PRT:

E.Q.: (a) Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with atleast 50% marks and 02 years Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known). **OR** Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with atleast 45% marks and 02 years Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known), accordance with the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure), Regulations, 2002, **OR** Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with atleast 50% marks and 04 years Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.), **OR** Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with atleast 50% marks and 02 years Diploma in Education (Special Education). (b) Pass in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) in accordance with the Guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose/Teacher Eligibility Test (TET). (c) Competence to teach both through Hindi & English medium.

NOTE: In case of non-availability of suitable CTET/TET candidates, candidates without CTET/TET may also be considered for the post of TGT (Vyakaran, Sahitya, Jyotish and Veda).

Age: Minimum and maximum age limit shall be 18 & 65 years respectively.

The other contents of the concerned advertisement shall remain unchanged.
