Capacity Building Programme on Research, Teaching and Learning Process for the Faculty in Social Sciences (1st December 2017 to 14th December 2017) with collaboration of Indian Council for Social Sciences Research, New Delhi

#### **Report of the Capcity Building Programme**

Inaugural session of this capacity building programme started with the key notes address by Prof Prithvish Nag, vice chancellor of MGKVP University. In his, He focused on how we can conduct our research while using different methodology as per the discipline which we are working on and are from. Then second lecture was chaired by Prof. Jaikant Tiwary. Sir laid emphasis on the development of capacity, as a tool to enhance the research output. He actually guided us through the different examples (i.e. current examples) which need to be focused when one is concerned with Capacity Building. He also explained why Capacity building is important for the teachers. He said" Capacity is a process by which a person retains knowledge to gain a job. Then, Prof T. P. Singh Sir has given a brief introduction about the program as well as about the participants. After inaugural session, two lectures were delivered on the same day. Prof. B. V. Singh delivered a lecture on "The Epistemology of quantitative parallels to qualitative phenomena". His lecture has indeed helped us to understand the various concepts related to quantitative and qualitative methods. Prof. R. C. Mishra taught the three basic concepts of research in terms of its ontology, epistemology, and axiology. His philosophical orientation has cleared the concept of research in terms of its philosophical roots. He laid emphasis of culture and cultural differences in this respect. He also emphasized the role of triangulation in this respect. His lecture made the concept very lucid and clear.

On the second day, Prof. R. Raman delivered lecture on "Conducting and analyzing Interviews". He explained how we should conduct a interview and also what precaution is required while conducting it. A simplified description by him with regards to the underlying complexities of interview have made us comprehend the tricks and tactics of conducting interview effectively and also with maximum amount of knowledge about the topic of interest. Prof. Arvind Kumar delivered two lectures on "Academic paper Report" & also on "Research Proposal Writing". He discussed Academic writing in detailed namely through different notions of Academic writing, Challenges to theory building in Academic, tools in Academic Writing, significance and Relevance of Academic writing, etc. In addition, he said that a research proposal was indeed the most difficult task for any reseracher as it required information about several minute details before preparing a final draft.

On the third day, Prof G. P. Singh has delivered his lecture on "Elementary, Probability Theory & Probability distribution' and also on "Bivariate Correlation and Regression". He is one of the best resource persons amongst all the sessions which I had attended. He started with simple examples of daily life events towards the complex one and also explains their relevance as well as the importance for the statistical considerations in research.

On the fourth day, First and second sessions were presided by Prof. Prerana Mohite. She delivered a lecture on Research proposal writing. The unique aspect about her lecture was that she provided an opportunity to prepare a proposal in the session. This has indeed been a thing of great help to me. Third sessions presided by Prof. Dilip Mohite. He delivered his lectures on "Critical Strategic Mosaic of South Asia". His points evoked my interest into international

politics and what challenges India is currently facing in the present scenario and what strategies its opting in order to tackle the issues concerned.

On the fifth day, First and second sessions were presided by Prof. Ajit Pandey. His lectures were on the "Theoretical Discourse on Research methodology in Social Sciences". He covered various theoretical aspects which is important to know before conducting any type of research. Basic points around which the entire process of research is laid were captured very aptly by Prof. Pandey. The speaker of third session was Prof. A. R. Vijapur. His lecture was on "Ethics in Academic Writing". Writing a research paper is one of the most important as well as challenging task for the researcher. While writing any paper, it is important to take ethical consideration.

On the sixth day, Prof. A. R. Vijapur continued his lectures. In addition he spoke on the problem and prospects related to publication process. Then second session was presided by Prof. R. P. Pathak (Department of Political Sciences, BHU). He focused on the world wide political perspective. Indigenous perspective was the thing was emphasized by Prof. Pathak. The socio political thinkers and their views in this respect were emphasized by him. Third session was done by Dr. Navneet Gandhi. Her lecture was typically interesting due to the way in which she articulated the entire theme. Her emphasis on the topic "types, techniques & Challenges of Academic Writing". He stated that there are four kind of writing style namely, Descriptive, Analytical, Pursasive and Critical.

On the seventh day, Dr. Navneet Gandhi continued her lectures. In addition, she was focused on the topic i.e., how to convert the thesis into a book form. She also explained the difference between thesis and book. And also she discussed the precaution while converting thesis into book. Then second session was engaged by Prof. Priyankar Upadhyay. He discussed what challenges as a researcher has to faced while conducting the research work. In addition, he has shared his experiences too and also different ways to confront the challenges and how to tackle most of them. Then, Prof. Chandrakala Padia has given her lecture on "Feminist Methodology". She developed an insight on the significance of feminist methodology in the present research process. Thus it was emphasized to focus on the gender as an important variable in this context. On the Eighth day, Prof. Sanjay Singh (Vice- chancellor, Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Law University, Lucknow) delivered a very interesting lecture on the ethnography as a research tool. The impact of cultural and cross-cultural dimension was indeed a new thing for me. Prof Sanjay Pandey (JNU, New Delhi) was delivered a lecture.

On the ninth day, Dr. Upendendra Chaudhry (Director, ICSSR, New Delhi) has focused on the information related to the functioning and mission of ICSSR. Even, he discussed various form of fellowship, grants, projects and so on available to the academicians at various level of education. His lecture is one of the best lectures from the entire sessions that we attended. The information was indeed very informative for academician like me.

On the tenth day, Holiday (SUNDAY)

On the eleventh day, Prof. T. B. Singh has delivered a wonderful lecture on the qualitative research methodology and on how statistics could help in the process of quantifying few aspects of it. Report of the 7 days Workshop on the topic "Research Methodology in Social Sciences" organized by the Centre for Study of Social Exclusion and Inclusive Policy" Faculty of Social Sciences, BHU (15th Feb. 2018 to 21st February 2018)

With the blessings of Mahamana Pt. Madan Mohan Malaviya ji. The seven days National Workshop on "Research Methodology in Social Sciences" was organized by the Centre for Study of Social Exclusion & Inclusive Policy, Faculty of Social Sciences, BHU. The venue for the organization was the seminar hall of Centre itself and it included nearly 80 research scholars from the various disciplines of Social Sciences, Arts, Law and Education too.

The seminar was inaugurated on 15<sup>th</sup> of February, where the presiding speech was given by the Dean of the Faculty, where he mentioned the importance of research in the current scenario. The Chief Guest of the day was the eminent journalist and foreign policy analyst Shri Seshadri Ramanujan Chari ji, was addressed the gathering by giving a short lecture which dell with the issues related to China & Sudan.

On the same day after a tea break, the second session was conducted. The resource person for 2<sup>nd</sup> session was Prof. Bhupendra Vikram Singh from Dept. of Economics, BHU. He dell with the different philosophical aspects of research in present scenario. He also encouraged the new research scholars to go for inter disciplines research as he said no social science discipline alone can come up with any solution to any problem.
