### Know Your University – The Sayaji Rao Goekwad Central Library

The Sayaji Rao Goekwad Central Library of the University was started in 1917 with a donation of books by Shri P.K. Telang in memory of his father Justice K.T. Telang. The collection was housed in the Telang Hall of the Central Hindu College, Kamachha. In 1921, the library was moved to the Central Hall of the Arts College (now the Faculty of Arts). It was nurtured in its infancy by the renowned historian Sir Jadunath Sarkar. The present Central Library of BHU was established with a donation from Maharaja Sayaji Rao Goekwad III of Baroda. The reading room was designed on the pattern of reading room of British Library located in British Museum. Its majestic circular Central Hall has been furnished with elegant furniture's made of famous and rare variety of Burma Teak woods. In the initial years the library got enriched by donations of personal collection of books by men of repute like Lala Sri Ram of Delhi, Jamnalal Bajaj of Wardha, Roormal Goenka, Batuk Nath Sharma, Tagore & Nehru Family etc. and their personal collections are still housed in the library.

The library today is spread in total area of 6781.7 sq. Mts. with seating capacity of 670 persons. It has reading carrels, lounge area for browsing and relax reading and IT zone for accessing e-resources etc. The library has more than 1.4 million print book, back volume and theses, subscribe more than 500 print journals and has about 1.3 lac back volume of journals. It has more than ten thousand e-journals and forty thousand e-books. It has special section for visually impaired students. The Central Library has very rich collection of manuscripts. It has more than seven thousand manuscripts available in Sanskrit, Urdu, Arabic, Persian, Bhoti, Newari and Modi scripts. Since Feb 2006, the library has become a designated *Manuscript Conservation Centre* (MCC) of the National Mission for Manuscripts. The digital library is available to students and staff and provides online access to thousands of journals, besides access to large collections of online resources through the National Informatics Centre's DELNET and UGC's INFLIBNET.
