SECTION I: NOTICE INVITING TENDERS (NIT) (GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS)

Sub: Submission of Quotation/ offer for Rate Contract for Medicines for Hospital Supply.

Your attention is drawn on the subject cited above. In this context this is to inform you that we intend to purchase various medicines & dressing materials for the use of University Employees Health Care Complex/University Students Health Care Complex & S.S. Hospital, B.H.U. for the session 2017-18 and onwards to the tune of approximately Rs. 15 Crore per annum.

You are therefore requested to submit your quotation/offer for **Rate Contract** of the Medicines preferably **Generic Form** and also branded one's for the Hospital supply. The Quotations/offers should be uploaded on the Govt. web site e-procure.

Online tenders, in two-bid system, are invited from reputed bidders having at least three years experience of dealing with the Government Organisations for Rate Contract of items as per enclosed specification and related terms and conditions.

- 1. Bidders are required to register on the Central Public Procurement Portal at www.eprocure.gov.in, using a valid Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) and valid email address to be able to participate in the bidding process. On registration with the Portal they will be provided with a user id and password by the system through which they can submit their bids online.
- 2. Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) may be obtained from any authorized agencies registered with the Certifying Authority (CA), through National Informatics Centre (NIC) in India.
- 3. Bidders can download the bid document from Central Public Procurement Portal website at www.eprocure.gov.in Vendors are required to submit the bid online by scanning and uploading all the relevant documents through www.eprocure.gov.in
- 4. Tender document can also be downloaded from the University website at www.bhu.ac.in For further details regarding Amendment /Addendum /Extension please visit website: www.eprocure.gov.in and www.bhu.ac.in

Please also note the following :-

Tenders are invited for and only from the own manufacturer (Distributor, or agent) *and* from direct importer and if importer is not available from their authorized importer or agent the for fixing rate contract for supply of drugs & Pharmaceuticals, surgical items and consumables to Sir Sunder Lal Hospital and Health Care Complex, Banaras Hindu University, U.P.

The rate Contract will be awarded to manufacturer, the manufacturer however can authorize the distributor/ stockiest for collecting purchase orders, supply the goods and collect the payment on behalf of its firm. Authorize agents and distributor are not eligible for participating in the tender.

Only those manufacturers/companies are eligible to Quote their Hospital Rates who have an annual turnover of a minimum of Rs. 100 Crore along in every year during last three years with WHO GMP certificate & Loan Manufacturing License. Certificates to the same effect from registered Chartered Accountant and from the concerned Drug authorities FDA should be uploaded in the tender document.

The manufacturer/company quoting for medicines must upload the following documents in addition to above certificates:

- 1. Registration number of the Company.
- 2. GST Registration
- 3. PAN Number of the Company
- 4. Form No. 20B and 21B.
- 5. Import license issued by Central Drugs Standards Control Organisation (CDSCO)
- 6. Valid OWN drug manufacturing license
- 7. Quality Assurance Certificate issued by concerned FDA stating that the firm has not been prosecuted and convicted during last three years for violation of Drugs & Cosmetic Acts and Rules there under List of product licensed by drug control administration. Along with certified copy of valid Drug selling

License of the Importer.

- 8. Valid WHO /G.M.P.Certicate for Own or Loan License from concered FDA of a premises where medicines are manufactured
- 1. C.E./U.S. FDA certificate (wherever applicable).
- 2. Valid import license Form 10 along with list of imported items/device/drugs.
- 3. Import Export certificate (IEC) for the items which do not come under drug category
- 4. Authority letter issued by foreign manufacturer for importing the product for which bid is offered OR Contract agreement between foreign manufacturer and Importer.
- Period of validity of rates should be not for less than two years preferably up to the approval of new rate contract.
- No upward revision of prices shall be entertained during the rate contract period, except in case of statutory taxes imposed by the govt. However, any rate reduction during contract period due to tax relief should be immediately informed to the authorities, so as to reduce the awarded rate accordingly.
- Name & Address along with contact number and e-mail of the manufacturing company and local distributor/Stockist, must be mentioned for any further enquiry. A power of attorney should be submitted by the manufacturer in the name of person who will be responsible for rate negotiation if needed.
- Special/Institutional offer (if any) on bulk supply should clearly be mentioned.
- Performance Guarantee @ 5% to the purchase order amounting to Rs. 5,00,000/- & above will have to be submitted by the bidder at the time of supply of the order in the form of Bank Guarantee in form of Fixed Deposite Recipt (FDR) from a nationlised or govt. approved bank.
- An authenticated copy of products, if any, under valid rate contract with DGSD/DGHS/ESIC (Central Rate Contract, New Delhi.) Session 2017-18 should be sent, along with letter of agreement stating that the firm is agree to supply the surgical items and medicines under these contracts.
- The Vendor will be manufacture or direct importer for the rate contract and also for the supply of items. The agents/ Distributors will not be allowed to participate and However, the manufacturer can give authority to its authorized agent or distributor for raising the bills and collecting the payments on behalf of manufacturer.
- The manufacturer should have a) WHO, Good Manufacturing Certificate (G.M.P.), b) Own License to manufacturer, c) The certificate from state FDA, stating that the manufacturer has WHO, GMP certificate, Own License and have not been prosecuted and/or not been convicted under Drugs & cosmetic Acts & Rules, during last three years. If the tenderer has not WHO/GMP for Own License, but has WHO/ GMP for Loan License, in that case, the WHO/GPM for Loan Licenses premises should be produced and medicines should be supplied from the Loan manufacturing premises holding WHO/GMP certificate.
- **Calling of Tender and Finalization of Rate Contract** Item-wise Rate contract valid for two years will be finalized and will be published in a small book format and all the purchasers will be instructed to follow this contract and purchase items as per their need over a period of two years. If the new contract is not finalized before the expiry of the old rate contract, the old contract would be extended for maximum period of six months.
- Matching the lowest rates-Once the item wise lowest rates are finalized, all the bidders who have quoted rates higher than the lowest rate will be called to match the L1 rates. Those who agree to supply these items will be called and agreement will be signed with three of them as an alternate source in ratio of 60, 40, and 20. This is done so that there is always a standby supplier at the lowest approved rate. Medicines being very essential and lifesaving items, this is very much essential to have uninterrupted supply.
- **Monitoring of supply & Supplier's performance** –There will be a committee for monitoring the quality of supplied items and supplier's performance. In case of medicines where there is doubt about the quality of product medicines as well surgical dosposables, this committee will call the samples of such

items for the evaluation and samples will be tested in NABI accredited lab. Or in any other authorized agency before opening of price bid.

SUPPLIES

As regards labeling & packing, the provisions of Drugs & Cosmetics Act, 1940 & the rules there under with latest amendments should be distinctively specified on each unit of label.

- 1. Name of Drug.
- 2. Specification under which the drug is manufactured viz. I.P./B.P./USP/NFI & its year etc.
- 3. Name of manufacturer with address.
- 4. Name of the importer, License No. Country of origin of manufacturing the product
- 5. Drug License number under which the drug has been manufactured
- 6. Batch number.
- 7. Date of expiry of potency.
- 8. Date of manufacture.
- 9. Net Contents
- 10. Formula with ingredients, its strength as per pharmacopoeia (year of pharmacopoeia also should be mentioned)
- 11. Specific storage condition.

12. Every batch supplied must have in printed on its label "Hospital IMS-BHU Supply and not for Sale"

- 13. Specific doses for pediatric and geriatric patients.
- 14. Specific dose measuring droppers/measuring devices should be provided in case pediatric dosage forms.
- No product marked with <u>"Hospital Supply and not for Sale"</u> marking meant for supply under the rate contract should be sold to public.
- The maximum time period permitted between the date of manufacture & date of supply of drugs shall not be more than ¹/₄ of the whole life period of such drugs.
- In case of vaccine & sera the date of supply of these drugs should not be more than $1/6^{th}$ of the whole life period.
- All the drugs should be packed & supplied in the prescribed packing only and as per the standard guidelines & FDA/ISI.
- Active ingredients used in formulation of items quoted shall be of Pharmacopoeia quality & specifications.
- All vaccines and Biological products should be tested by Central Drug Lab, Kasauli, Himachal Pradesh and batch wise test report to that effect should be attached with supplies.
- The Rate Contract Holder shall also be responsible for free replacement of Drugs/items for which there is no expiry date & which are found deteriorated.
- The ampoules used should be used as per standards laid down under latest Indian Pharmacopoeia, machine made, & long enough to prevent slipping of glass pieces in injection. One cutter should be provided per box of Hundred ampoules. The vials used should also be as per standard laid down in latest Indian Pharmacopoeia.
- The oral liquids supplied in small bottle should be accompanied by plastic measure correctly marked for desired doses. and leaflet mentioning dose regimen should be inserted with each container. The bottles not accompanying plastic measures will be rejected at the time of supply by store in charge
- All the supplies made by a successful tenderer shall bear following certificate on every Challan & every bill/invoice duly signed.
- "The products supplied under this Challan invoice are manufactured as per standards mentioned in pharmacopoeia/I.S.I. standard, & the product is of standard quality. We are solely responsible for the defect/deviation from the standards, if found any time in future."
- All supplies of Drugs Items should accompany a quality test certificate in respect of each batch, mentioning all the tests carried from a laboratory / chemist approved by FDA. The said certificate must be signed by FDA approved laboratory/chemist. The full name, Qualification of FDA- approved

laboratory/chemist must be mentioned and the supply without such batch wise test report should not be accepted by the concern store in charge.

- The Vendor will be manufacture or direct importer for the rate contract and also for the supply of items. The agents/ Distributors will not be allowed to participate and also will not be allowed to supply the items. However, the manufacturer can give authority to its authorized agent or distributor for raising the bills and collecting the payments on behalf of manufacturer.
- The manufacturer should have a) WHO, Good Manufacturing Certificate (G.M.P.), b) Own License to manufacturer, c) The certificate from state FDA, stating that the manufacturer has WHO, GMP certificate, Own License and have not been prosecuted and/or not been convicted under Drugs & cosmetic Acts & Rules, not even once during last three years and d) Minimum Annual Financial Turnover of Rs. 100 Crore during preceding three years.
- Calling of Tender and Finalization of Rate Contract- Item-wise Rate contract valid for two years will be finalized and will be published in a small book format and all the purchasers will be instructed to follow this contract and purchase items as per their need over a period of two years. If the new contract is not finalized before the expiry of the old rate contract, the old contract would be extended for maximum period of one year.
- **Matching the lowest rates-** Once the item-wise lowest rates are finalized; all the bidders who have quoted rates higher than the lowest rate will be called to match the L1 rates. Those who agree to supply these items in the failure of supply from the lowest bidder will be called and agreement will be signed with them as an alternate source in case the lowest bidder fails to supply, so that there is always a standby supplier at the lowest approved rate.
- **Monitoring of supply & Supplier's performance** There will be a committee for monitoring the quality of supplied items and supplier's performance.

PROCEDURE OF SUPPLY :

The concerned unit of purchase department will send the purchase order by email Registered Post/Speed Post/ to the tenderer. The Rate Contract holder should acknowledge the receipt of the order to the concerned unit by email, letter sent by Register post/Speed Post/email within 7 days stating the exact delivery period required & quantities he will be supplying, which should not be more than Thirty days from the date of receipt of order. If Rate Contract holder is not in a position to supply the entire quantity indented, he will inform the concerned unit under registered post letter/Speed Post/ email and obtain a permission for extension of delivery period from the Medical Superintendent / CMO Incharge in writing, failing which he will be liable for penalty for delay in supply.

If the Rate Contract holder fails to supply within the stipulated delivery period from the date of receipt of order by e-mail, Registered Post/Under certificate of posting/fax/email, penalty at the rate of 0.5% of the cost of ordered quantity per week or part thereof supplied late by him will be charged & the same will be deducted from the bill of the contract holder. The maximum limit for the penalty will be 10% of the cost of ordered quantity.

The Payment will be made within 60 days after the receipt of the store.

PENALTIES FOR SUPPLY OF SUBSTANDARD PRODUCT, QUOTING HIGHER PRICES AND FORGED DOCUMENTS

The contractors should note that –If the quality of particular batch of drugs supplied is declared substandard in any of the following category by the drug authorities following actions will be taken .

- A) Drugs declared "Misbranded" 'Adulterated' & Spurious' as per Drugs & Cosmetics Act" 1940 amended from time to time.
 - **1.** The contract of the firm for the said item will be cancelled.
 - **2.** The extra expenditure incurred if any because of risk purchase shall be recovered from the contract holder.
 - **3.** EMD and Security Deposit of the contract holder will be forfeited.
 - **4.** Purchase cost of full order irrespective of its consumed quantity shall be recovered from rate contract holder from the outstanding bills or Security Deposit.
 - 5. The goods which are not used, but belong to the said substandard batch shall be destroyed by the concerned store in the presence of/or under intimation to Food and Drug Administration officials. The necessary expenditure incurred for this shall be recovered from the rate contract holder.
 - 6. The rate contract firm will be debarred from participating in tender for next three years.
- **B**) Drugs declared "Not of Standard Quality" as per drugs & Cosmetics Act, 1940 amended from time to time.
 - 1. The cancellation of contract for the specified item shall be decided by the Medical Superintendent, S. S. Hospital, after reviewing the severity of sub-standard quality of item in consultation with the FDA. The testing report issued by Food & Drug Administration or F.D.A. approved laboratory regarding quality shall be final & binding on the contract holder.
 - 2. The extra expenditure incurred if any because of risk purchase shall be recovered from the contract holder.
 - **3.** Purchase cost of full order irrespective of its consumed quantity shall be recovered from rate contract holder from the outstanding bills or Security Deposit.
 - **4.** The goods which are not used, but belong to the said substandard batch shall be destroyed by the concerned store in the presence of/or under intimation to Food and Drug Administration officials. The necessary expenditure incurred for this shall be recovered from the rate contract holder.
 - 5. The EMD of the contractor will be forfeited.
- C) In case the tenderer **quotes prices higher** than allowed as per DPCO, NPPA or higher than MRP or/and fails to supply the goods consistently the tenderers will be **declared as a Fraudulent and defaulters**

- 1. The extra expenditure incurred because of extra cost and because of risk purchase shall be recovered from the contract holder.
- 2. The Contract holder's EMD, Security Deposit will be forfeited.
- 3. The contract holder will be debarred from participating in the tender for next three years.
- **D**) In case if found that the tenderer has submitted **forged documents** the following actions will be taken against the tenders.
 - **1.** The police case will be filed against the tenderer.
 - 2. The tenderer's EMD, Security Deposit will be forfeited.
 - 3. The tenderer will be debarred from participating in the tender for next three years.
- E) In case if found that the goods supplied by the tenderer have been declared "Not of Standard Quality" by FDA in case of more than three items the following actions will be taken
 - **1.** The extra expenditure incurred if any because of risk purchase shall be recovered from the contract holder.
 - 2. The all rate contracts of the tenderer will be cancelled.
 - 3. The contract holder's EMD, Security Deposit will be forfeited.
 - 4. The contract holder will be debarred from participating in the tender for next three years.

All matters of dispute/litigations shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Varanasi, U.P.

Note : The manufacturer provisionally selected for Rate Contract will have to submit duly certified hard copy of all the essential documents as mentioned above.
