Advertisement for the post of Junior Research Fellow in DST-SERB Project P-07/725

Applications are invited from Indian nationals for one post of Junior Research Fellow with a salary of Rs. 31,000 p.m. without HRA as per the Govt. of India rules in a DST-SERB sponsored project entitled "Remote sensing based risk assessment of coal fires in Jharia Coalfield, India". The post is sanctioned for duration of three years.

The candidate must have good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in Remote Sensing and GIS/ Geo-informatics/ Geology/ from an Indian University. Besides fulfilling the aforesaid qualifications, candidates must be NET/GATE qualified. The upper age limit should not exceed 28 years. A relaxation of 5 years will be given to SC/ST/Physically challenged/ Female candidates. All things being equal, SC/ST candidates will be preferred as per GOI rules. The candidate with working knowledge on the Digital Image Processing software's like ENVI, SARscape, ERDAS Imagine etc. shall be preferred.
