

Research positions under DBT/Wellcome Trust India Alliance Project

Applications are invited for the following temporary positions available under and co-terminus with a DBT/Wellcome Trust India Alliance sponsored research project (BHU Project Code No. M-02-28) entitled "Deciphering the role of DNA damage response pathways in the myeloid-type progenitor cells differentiation using *Drosophila*."

1. Graduate Research Assistant (one post @ ₹ 31,000/-pm + HRA 16%)

Essential qualifications: The candidates should hold M.Sc. in Zoology/Biochemistry/Life Science or a related field (with 55% and above) and have qualified CSIR-UGC NET/GATE/National level examinations conducted by DST, DBT, ICMR, IIT, ISc, IISER, etc. The upper age limit is 28 years. Relaxation of 5 years for SC/ST/Female/Physically Handicapped candidate and 3 Years for OBC candidate. All things being equal, SC/ST candidates will be preferred as per GOI rules.

Desirable qualifications: The candidate should have practical knowledge in genetics, imaging, molecular and cell biology. Candidates having research experience in the relevant area will be preferred.

2. Lab Attendant (one post @ ₹16000/- pm, consolidated)

Responsibility: Lab Attendant will help with the various aspects of the project, such as fly food preparation, *Drosophila* stocks and laboratory maintenance, and other academic/administrative work assigned by PI.

Essential Qualifications: Graduate or Intermediate in science subjects with 2-3 years of work experience in a research laboratory. The candidate should be aware of basic computer operation (Typing, MS Office).

Upper age limit is 30 years (5 years relaxation for SC/ST/Physically Handicapped/Female candidates, 3 years for OBC candidates). Upper age limit may be relaxed for earlier work in a project/scheme in BHU as per the University rules. All things being equal, SC/ST candidates will be preferred as per GOI rules. Candidates' work experience in the relevant area will be preferred. Selection will be through a skill/written test.
