NOTIFICATION

In pursuance to the decision taken in the Governing Body of IoE meeting held on 20.07.2022, the following new scheme is being introduced with immediate effect:

Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan Internship

Under this scheme, students enrolled in Master's degree programs in Library Science, Education, Physical Education, Visual Arts, and Performing Arts, B.Ed. and MCA will be allowed to undergo internship within the University system for a period of one year. The Scheme will also be applicable for person having degree in any discipline and having awarded with Gold/Silver/Bronze medal in any national or international events. They will be provided an emolument of Rs. 20,000/- p.m.

The eligible students will apply on proforma (available on BHU website under IoE Section) through their Heads to the Dean. The number of interns will be decided through a Screening Committee.

The aforesaid scheme will be managed by Sponsored Research Industrial Consultancy Cell (SRICC).

The expenditure on the above will be met out from the Recurring head "Master/Doctors and Post-Doctoral Fellows" under IoE Scheme (Dev. Scheme No.6031(A).

Guidelines for Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan Internship (SRK Internship)

In order to provide an exposure of profession and to improve employability, Banaras Hindu University proposes to start an internship program for BHU students in the following disciplines in the first instance. More disciplines may be added with time:

- 1. Library Science
- 2. Education
- 3. Physical Education
- 4. Visual Arts
- 5. Performing Arts

The SRK Internship will help BHU students to gain professional experiences, build their resume and will provide them a stepping stone to launch their career. Objectives of SRK Internship include the following:

- (i) Expose the student to the environment and expectations of performance in their professions'
- (ii) Enhance the student's knowledge in the profession.
- (iii) Develop a work ethic and professional demeanour, as well as a commitment to ethical conduct and social responsibility.
- (iv) Assist the student's development of employer-valued skills such as teamwork communications etc.

Duration: One year

Number of internships: In the first instance, up to 100 internships are proposed.

Emoluments: Rs. 20,000/- pm (Fixed). May be revised from time to time.

Eligibility:

For Library Sciences: candidate should have master degree in Library science or Master in Computer Applications;

For Education: B.Ed. or M. Ed;

For Physical Education; Master in Physical Education OR person having degree in any discipline and won Gold/Silver/Bronze medal in any national or international events: and

For 'Visual and Performing Arts: Master in Visual or Performing Arts OR person having degree in any discipline and won Gold/Silver/Bronze medal in any national or international events.

Selection: A discipline level screening committee will shortlist eligible applicants for the internship. The Vice Chancellor will form a University level committee (or more than one committee) which will interview the shortlisted candidates and make appropriate recommendations for consideration to the Vice Chancellor.

Opportunity: The selected candidates will be assigned the job place depending on their qualifications and available opportunities. They are expected to work full-time in the respective units as assigned by the respective in charges.
