NOTIFICATION

In pursuance to the decision taken in the Governing Body of IoE meeting held on 20.07.2022, the following new scheme is being introduced with immediate effect:

Program for Visiting Professors / Scholars, Sportsmen, Artists-In-Campus

Under this program, a proposal be submitted by the Head, Dean, Director, Coordinator (IoE), the Rector or the Vice-Chancellor for consideration by a Committee, to invite Visiting Professors, Scholars, Artists, Sportsmen, etc. to contribute towards the academic and professional development of the university community.

Visiting Professors, Scholars, Artists, Sportsmen under above program will be provided a consolidated weekly honorarium ranging between Rs. 20,000/- to 40,000/-, economy class travel expenses, semi furnished accommodation, office space and access to the university's facilities. A minimum of six weeks stay in the University would be mandatory for getting international travel expenses. The principle guidelines of the Program is pasted overleaf.

The aforesaid program under IoE will be managed by Sponsored Research Industrial Consultancy Cell (SRICC).

The bills towards the payment of honorarium and other expenses under this program will be submitted to the Prof. In-charge, SRICC for payment. The expenditure on the above will be met out from the **Recurring** head "Salary of Adjunct/Visiting Faculty" under IoE Scheme (Dev. Scheme No.6031(A).

Principle Guidelines of the Program

Visiting Professor: Visiting faculty members will be involved in teaching and research activities for a period ranging from two months to a year. The term may be extended based on mutual interest. Those on a one-year appointment may be permitted to submit and manage sponsored projects as PI with the regular faculty members as co-PI.

When appropriate, academics may be designated as Visiting Associate Professor or Visiting Assistant Professor or Visiting Faculty Member.

Scholars-in-Campus: Outstanding academics and scholars from India and abroad can be invited to spend their time in the campus. The hosted scholars may utilize the opportunity to work on manuscripts, develop research ideas or collaborative research proposals with University faculty members, conduct workshops or conferences, or help to develop curricula for new courses and programmes. The duration of her/his visit may range from three weeks to three months.

Sportsman-in-Campus and Artist-in-Campus: Renowned artists/sportsman (National and International award winners) may be invited to engage with students, staff and faculty members. It will provide an opportunity to the University community to advance human creativity within and beyond their discipline, and to connect with new ideas. The duration of her/his visit may range from one week to three months.
